SUBJECT: State Grant Application - Airport Improvement Project

DATE: September 6, 2011

NEEDS: For the City Council to approve a resolution authorizing the application and acceptance

of an Airport Improvement Program (AIP) matching grant from the California

Department of Transportation (Caltrans) for an airport improvement project.

FACTS: 1. The City has received grant funding from the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) in the amount of \$551,000.00.

2. Public Utilities Code section 21683.1 grants authority to the State Department of Transportation to provide grant funding to match FAA grants in the amount of 2.5

% of the federal funding amount.

3. As a condition of application for state funding the City is required to authorize its

application and acceptance by resolution.

ANALYSIS AND

CONCLUSION: The need to repair and rehabilitate the asphalt surface of the main airport runway

has been sufficiently demonstrated. The FAA has awarded grant funding for the maintenance work, including repainting of runway markings. The availability of grant funding from State and Federal sources allows the City to continue to effectively operate and maintain the Airport. The state matching grant is an

additional resource available to aid in the effort.

FISCAL

IMPACT: The total project cost is estimated to be \$580,000, with 95% participation from the

FAA (\$551,000.00) and the 2.5% State matching funding would be \$13,775. The current City share of this project is \$15,225. The fiscal impact to the City without this State matching grant would be the additional \$13,775. A more precise budget

will be presented after construction bids are received.

OPTIONS: A. Approve Resolution No. 11-xx, authorizing the application and acceptance of State

Department of Transportation matching grant funding as specified.

B. Amend, modify, or reject the above option.
