PROCLAMATION

Law Enforcement Records and Support Personnel Day November 3, 2011

WHEREAS, law enforcement depend upon law enforcement records and support personnel to provide them with vital services; and

WHEREAS, this day has been declared by the California Law Enforcement Association of Records Supervisors (CLEARS), and recognized by Governor Brown; and

WHEREAS, the Paso Robles Police Department Records Bureau processes all traffic citations, crime reports, arrest reports, traffic collision reports, public records requests, and serves as the central receiving point for all subpoenas and discovery requests; and

WHEREAS, the Paso Robles Police Department Records Bureau staff entered thousands of documents into the Records Management System, processed multiple subpoenas as court liaison, and provided Live Scan services to hundreds of citizens; and

WHEREAS, the first personal contact by a citizen at the Paso Robles Police Department is with the Paso Robles Police Department Records Bureau staff at the front counter, and they assisted or provided service to over 8,000 citizens in 2010; and

WHEREAS, the Paso Robles Police Department Records Bureau staff exhibit compassion, understanding, and professionalism during the performance of their job; and

WHEREAS, it is important to recognize Paso Robles Police Department's law enforcement records and support personnel for their valuable contributions to our criminal justice system.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that I, Duane Picanco, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor, and speaking on behalf of the entire City Council, do hereby proclaim November 3, 2011 as **LAW ENFORCEMENT RECORDS AND SUPPORT PERSONNEL DAY** in the City of Paso Robles, and extend our gratitude to the Paso Robles Police Department Records Bureau staff and support personnel for their dedicated service to our community, their diligence, and their commitment to keeping our City and citizens safe.
