NEEDS: For City Council to consider awarding a construction contract to upgrade sewers that

serve the Oak Park Housing Project.

FACTS:

1. The City's adopted Sewer Master Plan has identified the existing 8-inch sewer line at the north end of Pine Street between Pine and Riverside is deficient under build-out load (see attached location map).

- 2. This sewer line crosses under the railroad tracks and ties into a manhole in Riverside, eventually discharging to the Wastewater Treatment Plant.
- 3. In 2010, the City was informed that the Paso Robles Housing Authority was working on a plan to redevelop the Oak Park area. In preparation for this redevelopment, the City initiated the design to upgrade the sewer lines.
- 4. Bid documents were prepared and advertised for bids.

5. At the bid opening on February 21, 2013, nine bids were received as follows:
