Needs: $\quad$ For the City Council to consider expanding the size of the Sales Tax Oversight Committee to nine (9) people, and to make formal appointments after completion of interviews.

Facts: 1. In December 2012, the City Council formed the Supplemental Sales Tax Oversight Committee and adopted its bylaw s.
2. The size of the committee was set at seven (7) members to be populated with three (3) Council selectees plus four (4) recommended by community organizations.
3. There was significant public interest in serving on the Oversight Committee and the City Council has interviewed twenty five (25) citizens for the three Council selectee positions.
4. At their meeting of February 28, 2013, the City Council indicated a desire to expand the size of the Oversight Committee from seven members to nine in order to allow the Council to select a total of five (5) members from the citizen interview process.
5. Amended Supplemental Sales Tax Oversight Committee Bylaws are attached, reflecting the expanded membership size in Section 3(c).
6. Community organizations identified by the City Council have made their Oversight Committee membership recommendations as follows:

Chamber of Commerce

- Jeff Bower

Paso Robles M ain Street

- Stephen King

Senior Advisory Committee

- Bill Pluma

Travel Paso Robles Alliance

- Victor Popp

7. The Oversight Committee Bylaws call for staggered three (3) year terms. To establish this staggered pattern, the Council will need to choose one (1) member from the Council appointee category, and two (2) members from the Community Organization appointees, to serve for initial terms of two (2) years.

## Analysis \&

Conclusion: The City Council is scheduled to interview the top eleven (11) citizen finalists on M arch 21, 2013, after which time both citizen and community group representative appointments can be finalized. Amending the bylaws to allow for a nine (9) member committee will allow five (5) citizens to be selected and appointed by the City Council in addition to the four (4) community group representatives.

Options: 1. For the City Council to:

# PASO ROBLES SUPPLEMENTAL SALES TAX REVENUE EXPENDITURE ADVISORY COMMITTEE 

## ARTICLE I - THE COMMITTEE

## Section 1: Name of Committee

The name of the Committee shall be the "Paso Robles Supplemental Sales Tax Revenue Expenditure Advisory Committee" (hereinafter referred to as the "Committee").

## Section 2: Purpose

The Committee serves at the pleasure of the City Council as a means to aid the City Council in gathering public input by providing a forum through which private citizens may review and advise the City Council of the City of Paso Robles ("City Council") on matters relating to Supplemental Sales Tax Revenue Expenditures. In order to accomplish that purpose, the Committee may consult with and advise the City Council on those matters which deal with the expenditures of revenues derived from a limited-term one-half percent General Sales Tax levied within the City of Paso Robles, approved by the voters in November 2012 ("Sales Tax Measure").

The Committee shall be and remain established for a period of 12 years following adoption of the Sales Tax Measure, unless otherwise abolished by an affirmative vote of the majority of the City Council.

## Section 3: Membership

a. Membership Categories and Qualifications

To be eligible for membership on the Committee, a person must be either a:
(1) Council Appointees: To qualify under this category, the person must be an individual selected by a majority vote of the City Council members.
(2) Community Organization Appointees: To qualify under this category, the person must be a member selected by a community organization (community organization to be determined by the City Council; e.g., Chamber of Commerce).
b. Open Membership

Criteria and selection for membership shall not discriminate based upon sex, race, religion, creed, color, age, marital status, national or ethnic origin, or any other classification protected by law.

## c. Total Membership \& Term Of Appointment

The total membership of the Committee shall be seven (7) nine (9) members. The total membership shall be allocated among the two membership categories, defined above, as follows: three (3) five (5) members from the from the Council Appointees category, and four (4) members from the Community Organization Appointees category.

A member's regular term of appointment shall be three (3) years. However, the initial term for one (1) member from the Council Appointees category and for two (2) members from the Community Organization Appointees category shall be for only two (2) years. Following this initial two (2) year term, the regular term of appointment for each of these members shall then be three (3) years.
(1) No person shall be eligible for appointment for more than three consecutive terms, exclusive of prior appointment to fill an unexpired term of office.
(2) Persons who have served three full consecutive terms may be reappointed following a one-term absence.
(3) Appointees shall serve on only one Council Advisory Body Commission at a time.
d. Member Code of Ethics

Committee members shall adhere to the City Council's Code of Ethics (Appendix).

## Section 4: Conflict of Interest

a. Committee members shall refrain from using their position to unduly influence the deliberations or decisions of the City Council or other City commission, board or committee.

## Section 5: Termination of Membership

Membership in the Committee shall terminate in the event that:
a. The member shall not be, or shall no longer be, a member of that membership category from and for which he or she was elected or appointed; or
b. The member shall have acted in violation of Section 9 of Article III of these Bylaws.
c. The member shall have served three consecutive full terms.

## Section 6: Removal of Members

A member may be removed by an affirmative vote of a majority of the City Council, if, after a hearing, it is found and determined that any one of the grounds for termination specified in Section 5 of this Article I exists.

## Section 7: Resignation

Any Committee member may resign at any time by giving written notice to the Chairperson, who shall forward such notice to the Committee and the City Council. Any such resignation will take effect upon receipt or upon any date specified therein. The acceptance of such resignation shall not be necessary to make it effective.

## Section 8: Filling of Vacancies

In the event of a vacancy on the Committee, the City Council shall select an individual to fill such vacancy as soon as reasonably practicable. New members must meet the qualifications set forth in Section 3 of Article I.

## Section 9: Remuneration

Members shall serve without pay except for reimbursement for travel expenses to meetings outside of the City, if any.

## ARTICLE II - OFFICERS

## Section 1: Officers

The officers of the Committee shall consist of a Chairperson and a Vice Chairperson, who shall be elected in the manner set forth in this Article II.

## Section 2: Chairperson

The Chairperson shall preside at all meetings of the Committee, and may submit such agenda, recommendations and information at such meetings as are reasonable and proper for the conduct of the business affairs and policies of the Committee. The Chairperson may sign documents necessary to carry out the business of the Committee.

## Section 3: Vice-Chairperson

The Vice Chairperson shall perform the duties of the Chairperson in the absence or incapacity of the Chairperson. In the event of the death, resignation or removal of the Chairperson, the Vice Chairperson shall assume the Chairperson's duties until such time as the Committee shall elect a new Chairperson.

## Section 4: Additional Duties

The officers of the Committee shall perform such other duties and functions as may from time to time be required by the Committee, these Bylaws, or other rules and regulations, or which duties and functions are incidental to the office held by such officers.

## Section 5: Election

The Chairperson and Vice Chairperson shall initially be elected from among the members of the Committee at the Committee's first regular meeting. Thereafter, the Chairperson and Vice Chairperson shall be elected from among the members of the Committee annually. The regular term of appointment for both officers shall be one (1) year. Officers of the Committee shall hold office until their successors are elected and in office. Any such officer shall not be prohibited from succeeding him or herself.

## Section 6: Removal of Officers

Upon an affirmative vote by a majority of the members of the Committee present at a regular or special meeting of the Committee at which a quorum is present, any officer may be removed from office, and a successor elected pursuant to Section 7 of this Article II.

## Section 7: Vacancies

Should the offices of the Chairperson or Vice Chairperson become vacant, the Committee shall elect a successor from among the Committee members at the next regular or special meeting, and such office shall be held for the unexpired term of said office.

## ARTICLE III - MEETINGS

## Section 1: Regular Meetings

The Committee shall meet on a semi-annual basis (every 6 months), at a location accessible to the public, in Paso Robles, California. A notice, agenda and other necessary documents shall be delivered to the members, personally or by mail, at least seventy-two (72) hours prior to the meeting.

## Section 2: Special Meetings

Special meetings may be held upon call of the Chairperson, or an affirmative vote by a majority of the members of the Committee present at a regular or special meeting of the Committee at which a quorum is present, for the purpose of transacting any business designated in the call, after notification of all members of the Committee by written notice personally delivered or by mail at least twenty-four (24) hours before the time specified notice for a special meeting. At such special meeting, no business other than that designated in the call shall be considered.

## Section 3: Adjourned Meetings

Any meeting of the Committee may be adjourned to another meeting date, time and place without the need for notice requirements of a special meeting, provided the adjournment indicates the date, time and place of the adjourned meeting. Committee members absent from the meeting at which the adjournment decision is made shall be notified by the Chairperson of the adjourned meeting.

## Section 4: All Meetings to be Open and Public

All meetings of the Committee shall be open to the public to the extent required by law. All persons shall be permitted to attend except as otherwise provided by law.

## Section 5: Posting Agendas/Notices

The City Staff member assigned to the Committee, or his or her authorized representative, shall post an agenda for each regular Committee meeting or a notice for each special Committee meeting containing a brief description of each item of business to be transacted or discussed at the meeting together with the time and location of the meeting. Agendas/notices shall be posted at the Paso Robles City Library at least seventy-two hours in advance of each regular meeting and at least twenty-four (24) hours in advance of each special meeting. The Staff Member shall maintain a record of such posting.

## Section 6: Right of Public to Appear and Speak

At every regular meeting, members of the public shall have an opportunity to address the Committee on matters within the Committee's subject matter jurisdiction. Public input and comment on matters on the agenda, as well as public input and comment on matters not otherwise on the agenda, shall be made during the time set aside for public comment; provided, however, that the Committee may direct that public input and comment on matters on the agenda be heard when the matter regularly comes up on the agenda. The Chairperson may limit the total amount of time allocated for public discussion on particular issues and/or the time allocated for each individual speaker.

## Section 7: Non-Agenda Items

Matters brought before the Committee at a regular meeting which were not placed on the agenda of the meeting shall not be acted upon by the Committee at that meeting unless action on such matters is permissible pursuant to the Ralph M. Brown Act (Gov. Code $\S 54950$ et seq.). Those non-agenda items brought before the Committee that the Committee determines will require Committee consideration and action and where Committee action at that meeting is not so authorized shall be placed on the agenda for a future meeting once a City staff report concerning the matter is prepared.

## Section 8: Quorum

The powers of the Committee shall be vested in the members thereof in office. Four (4) of the seven (7) members then in office shall constitute a quorum for the purpose of conducting the Committee's business, exercising its powers and for all other purposes, but less than that number may adjourn the meeting until a quorum is obtained. An affirmative vote by a majority of the members of the Committee present at a regular or special meeting of the Committee at which a quorum is present shall be required for approval of any questions brought before the Committee.

## Section 9: Unexcused Absences

If a member shall be absent without the consent of the Committee from three (3) consecutive meetings, whether regular or special, such absence shall result in the termination of the membership of the absenting member. A member's absence shall be excused if, prior to the meeting from which said member will be absent, said member notifies the Chairperson of his or her intent to be absent and the reasons therefore; provided, however, that a member shall be entitled to only two (2) excused absences within twenty-four (24) consecutive calendar months. At each meeting, after the roll has been called, the Chairperson shall report to the Committee the name of any member who has so notified him or her of his or her intent to be absent and the reason for such absence.

## Section 10: Order of Business

All business and matters before the Committee shall be transacted in conformance with the City Council's established practice.

## Section 11: Minutes (Action)

Minutes of the Committee shall be prepared in writing by the City staff member assigned to the Committee. Copies of the minutes of each Committee meeting shall be made available to each member of the Committee and the City Council. Approved minutes shall be filed in the official book of minutes of the Committee and forwarded to the City Council for information.

## Section 12: Recommendations to City Council

Recommendations of the Committee to the City Council shall be prepared in writing by the City staff member assigned to the Committee. Recommendations may be presented to the City Council during a public meeting once the assigned staff prepares a staff report summarizing key facts, analysis, costbenefit consideration, fiscal impact, and policy implications and options, and the report has been reviewed by the City Manager. The official minutes of the Committee documenting the Committee recommendation(s) shall be attached to the staff report.

## ARTICLE IV - REPRESENTATION BEFORE PUBLIC BODIES

The Chairperson, the Vice-Chairperson in the Chairperson's absence, or a member of the Committee may make official representations on behalf of the Committee before the City Council
only if so specifically designated by the Committee. The Committee may present information to other public bodies with the affirmative vote of a majority of the City Council. Nothing in this article shall limit the ability of members of the Committee to speak before the City Council or any other public body as an individual, provided the member states he or she is not representing or speaking on behalf of the Committee.

## ARTICLE V - COMMITTEES

The Committee may establish any standing and/or special committees it deems necessary consistent with, and to fulfill, its stated purpose as established in Section 2 of these Bylaws.

## ARTICLE VI - AMENDMENTS

These Bylaws may be amended upon an affirmative vote by a majority of the City Council.

Per my application to serve on the Tax Oversight Committee you will note that I am not a member of many organizations. Past experience includes serving as an executive board member of the American Nurses Assn., District 10, Santa Clara County, CA. I also served in various union officer roles as well as the legislative representative for Stanford Medical Center Nurses. For 25 years nursing was not just a job it was my passion. I made a difference in my profession. Now as a retiree I do what I believe I do best, attend City Council and Planning Commission meetings. However, when I feel my local government is threatened by individuals who are willing to make statements to the press without any attempt at back-up with facts, passion kicks in and I fight back.

It shouldn't be necessary to have a tax oversight committee (Anyone can oversee council actions every $2^{\text {nd }}$ and $4^{\text {th }}$ Tuesday of the month.) however, in view of an increase in distrust toward city government this past year it is probably a good idea. It will be another indication of the council's willingness to listen to local residents.

I wish to serve on the Tax Oversight Committee, not so much as to give advice to Council, but to serve in a capacity of educating the public regarding monies collected from the sales tax increase. I wish to be a part of a group that creates a balance to those who complain that "everything is done in secret...no public input."

An example of my skill in being able to make a difference is the attached letter I wrote in the Spring of 2010 as co-chair of the committee called Water4Paso. Issues were different but similar in that a few residents were loudly distorting the facts about Paso's water rates.

Water4Paso made a difference in getting water rates approved. I wrote letters to local newspapers, went door to door handing out my letter as well as a copy of Paso Robles Uniform Water Rate Chart. Paso has an opportunity to repair roads by voting for a sales tax increase. The ballot measure isn't confusing unless one believes confusing the public with misrepresentations of the truth works. Public meetings were held regarding the issue. Council took into account the advice of SLOCOG. (SLO Council of Governments) SLOCOG hired professional pollesters, who, after a scientific polling, found there was NO chance for a $2 / 3$ majority vote associated with a specific tax, but a majority vote associated with a general measure was possible. To reassure voters that money would be spent on roads an advisory measure was placed on the ballot, similar to the oversight committee appointed to monitor money associated with a previous school bond measure.

Business Times considers Paso Robles to be the economic anchor for North County, the distinction partially gained by the way it handles its budget. Using vigorous fiscal control Paso has maintained an AA credit rating. Individuals deserving credit are City Council, our City Manager and employees.

I will vote for a sales tax increase for road repair. Based upon past performance I see no reason not to trust our council to spend sales tax money on road repair.

My name is Kathy Barnett and I have agreed to co-chair a committee called Water4Paso.
I handed out a water rate chart so you can follow along with my comments. I believe without data and facts you're just another person with an opinion.

I am part of a coalition of residents and local businesses who care about Paso Robles and want to lend support to the city's Proposed Uniform Water Rates. We named ourselves Water4 Paso. I believe last November's water rate proposal was turned down mainly because of voter apathy. I voted but 8900 other registered Paso Robles residents didn't. I made a promise that if this issue goes to the ballot again I will be knocking on doors asking people to go vote.

Lately one of my my reasons for joining changed, it has to do with protest. I attend most council meetings figuring that it gives me the right to protest when I disagree with city proposals. Mainly it offers me an opportunity to participate in local government. I often disagree but I also take the time to thank council and staff when votes go in my direction.

Friends and former co-workers who know me well know that I have never been a passive observer when protest turns to a willful intent to distort the truth. Lately this is what seems to be happening in my city. I will be first to defend the right to protest but I will also fight for the truth.

A recent mailer from the Concerned Citizens group was sent to residents asking that they protest the new water rate proposal. At the bottom of the mailer was a graph indicating that, with the new rate structure, by 2015 my water bill would increase $335 \%$. This is a misrepresentation of the truth. Either that or the City is sending members of the Concerned Citizens group a special water bill. My current water bill contains charges for each unit of water plus an $\$ 18.00$ NWP fee. Perhaps Concerned Citizens receive a bill without this charge; the graph indicated you didn't need to include a monthly $\$ 18.00$ fee when you compare current charges to the new proposed rates.

I don't think the city is handing out special bills. Perhaps members of this group do not know how to do simple math...that is figure percentages...or could it be they deliberately intended to misrepresent the truth? I believe it is the latter. To compare current water rates to the new Uniform rates you have to start with your total current bill which includes a monthly $\$ 18.00$ fee. Currently a customer that uses 9 or less units of water each month would pay $29.88 /$ month. $\$ 1.32 \times 9$ units $=11.88+\$ 18$ equals 29.88 .

Using 9 units in 2011 saves me $\$ 7.88$ each month. In 2012 I save $\$ 1.08$. In 2013 I begin to experience a rate increáse $\$ 3.42$, in $2014 \$ 7.02$, in 2015 my rate will increase by $\$ 9.72$ On the water chart that I have handed out I calculated the cost of 1 to 50 units. You can go to 50 units in 2015 and still not reach a $335 \%$ increase.

I do not know who all received the mailer; it did get the attention of seniors. I am a senior living on a fixed income and would be down here at city hall screaming bloody
murder if I thought my water rates would soar $335 \%$. Our current rate includes the $\$ 18.00$ fee, with the new Uniform rate the $\$ 18.00$ fee is eliminated.

My other reasons for joining the Water4Paso committee are:

1. Paso Robles has a contract: One way or another, residents will pay for the Nacimiento Water Project. Filing lawsuits, telling people the city didn't allow residents to vote for the project will not negate the bill. Distorting facts and scaring residents is cruel.
2. It is forward thinking to have a secondary source of water. Supplemental water is needed to meet existing demand and improve quality.
3. The general fund is for libraries, parks \& recreation, our senior center, police and firemen. The fair way to pay the bill is through increased water rates. You pay only for what you use.
4. Council considered the impact of the NWP on growth and in March 2009 raised water connection fees from $\$ 9,119$ to $\$ 23,500 /$ residence.
5. To date we have spent almost $\$ 3$ million revising water rates; the current Uniform Rate is the $5^{\text {th }}$ proposal. The money spent revising proposals gets added to water bills. The longer we wait to increase rates the higher our water bills.
6. Last but not least, this as an opportunity to show support for my city. Our committee's has one primary goal: We are asking residents to support the Uniform Water Rate Proposal.
