COMMITTEE BUSINESS

2. City Liaison Reports – The City Council conducted their annual Goal Setting Workshop. The various dynamics of this effort are discussed. The airport continues to be a part of discussions regarding economic development within the community.

5. **Airport Business Plan** – The committee was given a Draft #2 at the last meeting for review and additional comment over the month. Mr. Corman reports on efforts to reduce the short-term focus of the plan, and to include a section outlining an effort to closely review current procedures and policies for viability in the current marketplace. The next steps of the review process are discussed. No other action is taken.

6. Committee Work Effort – After discussion, the following sub-committees are appointed: <u>Airport Promotion and Special Events</u> – Angel York <u>Airport Capital Improvement Program Review</u> – Ron Rose and Jim Willis <u>Airport Appearance and Beautification</u> – Lonnie Smith and Kevin Kuhn

It is the Committee's intent to complete the work of the Beautification and Capital Improvement sub-committees within one or two months and then move on to other work. The Promotion effort is intended to be more ongoing and will continue through the year... No other action is taken.
