CONSENT AGENDA

1. A motion was made by Trustee Alch, seconded by Trustee Carey, to approve the Minutes of the April 11, 2013 meeting. Motion passed. Voice vote: 4 ayes, no dissent.

DISCUSSION ITEMS

2. Advocacy Activities/Opportunities

-Trustee Carey noted that the recent Friends of the Library Book sale was a success with over \$2,000 raised. Some of the Trustees attended the recent Brushmarks reception

3. **Final Review of Bulletin Board and Free Distribution of Printed Materials Policy**

-After review, a motion was made by Trustee Carey, seconded by Trustee Lau, to approve the revised Bulletin Board and Free Distribution of Printed Materials Policy. Motion passed. Voice vote: 4 ayes, no dissent. Trustee Alch was thanked for her work on the revision.

4. <u>Review June 2013 Art</u>

-Art for the month of June was reviewed. Wall art will have the quilts of Maureen Handshy.

COMMUNICATIONS/REPORTS

-Karen Christiansen discussed the recent Friends of the Library book sale, and was thanked by Trustee Carey for her help with the post-sale clean up. Karen also talked about the Brushmarks art show and how it will incorporate the City's 125th anniversary next year. The Summer Reading Programs are taking shape. At a recent Black Gold meeting Christiansen reviewed new library software. Nancy Major and Dave Sequeira have been appointed to the Library Board of Trustees, terms to begin this July.

-Julie Dahlen told the Board that Black Gold has hired a consultant to analyze policies/fee schedules. The Taco Bell Track Meet was a success with nearly 300 children participating. Dahlen updated the Board regarding the summer aquatics program, the City's quasquicentennial preparations and the efforts of the City to be named a "bicycle friendly commuity."

-**Councilman Fred Strong** informed the Board that the roof on City Hall/Library will be replaced. He also talked about the convening of the Supplemental Tax Oversight Committee and the 21st Street project. Councilman Strong thanked termed-out Board members Bates and Carey for their service.

UNSCHEDULED MATTERS

-Trustee Alch asked Karen Christiansen about the discontinuing of the Library's Educator's Card program. Karen explained that the other Black Gold libraries did not favor altering their check-out periods, all patrons can renew items three times even without an Educator Card and delivery costs have increased.
