NEEDS:	Feder projec	he City Council to approve a resolution accepting an offer of grant funding from the ral Aviation Administration (FAA) for the design of an Airport taxiway rehabilitation ct and a separate resolution authorizing the City's application for a State Aviation hing grant for the project.
FACTS:	1.	The Airport Capital Improvement Program provides a long-term list of development and rehabilitation projects to support, maintain and expand the airport facility.
	2.	The next eligible project consists of rehabilitation (slurry seal and restriping) of two of the major airport taxiways (A & F) and the re-grading of an interior safety area.
	3.	The City has just received a Grant Offer from the FAA in the amount of \$145, 695.00 for a design-only grant to prepare the plans and specification for the subject rehabilitation project.
	4.	The FAA process requires the City's acceptance and execution of the grant offer/agreement before August 23, 2013, thus the urgent request for City Council action.
	5.	The State Aeronautics Program provides for an additional matching grant of 5% of the Federal amount. Once the FAA grant offer is received, the City may apply for the State matching grant.
analysis and		
CONCLUSION:		The proposed taxiway rehabilitation project is included in the Airport's approved Capital Improvement Program. The design work is done separately, ahead of the actual construction project, as requested by the FAA. The project is essential to the continued maintenance of the airport facility to the standards required.
FISCAL IMPACT:		The proposed design project is \$162,184.00. The Federal share requested is \$145,695.00 (90%), the second resolution (attached) authorizes an application to the State Aeronautics Program for a matching grant in the amount of \$8,921.00. The remaining \$7,298.00 is the City share, to be funded from the Airport Capital Improvement fund.
