## A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PASO ROBLES AWARDING A CONTRACT TO POTHOLE EXISTING UTILITIES FOR THE UNION ROAD PROJECT (KLECK TO MONTEBELLO OAKS)

WHEREAS, the City received a Bicycle Transportation (BTA) Grant to install bike lanes and improve the surface of Union Road from Kleck to Montebello Oaks; and

WHEREAS, in order to improve sight distance, the existing vertical crest will be removed by lowering the street profile approximately three to four feet; and

WHEREAS, with the need to change the vertical profile, existing utilities will need to be lowered as well; and

WHEREAS, the City must perform potholing in order to provide utility companies with information on the existing elevations of their respective facilities, so that they can prepare designs to lower the utilities; and

WHEREAS, bids were prepared and advertised, and at the bid opening on September 5, 2013, eight bids were received ranging from \$30,690 to \$77,696; and

WHEREAS, staff reviewed the low bid submitted by Pacific Coast Excavation and found it to be a responsive and responsible bid; and

WHEREAS, City Council has allocated \$683,500 to this project.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> The City Council of the City of Paso Robles does award a contract to Pacific Coast Excavation in the amount not to exceed \$30,690 for potholing Union Road (from Kleck to Montebello Oaks), and authorizes the City Manager to execute the contract.
