For City Council to consider using the City's USHA grant to refresh pavement NEEDS: striping and markings.

- FACTS: 1. In 2012 City Council used its share of the City's USHA grant to refresh pavement striping and markings of its arterial and collector streets.
  - 2. The USHA grant was not enough to do all the arterial and collector streets.
  - 3. SLOCOG has notified the City that \$120,400 in USHA grant monies is available for FY 2013/2014 allocation.

## **ANALYSIS &**

CONCLUSION: The following street segments are recommended to have pavement striping and markings refreshed using FY 2013/2014 USHA grant funds in the amount of \$120,400:

Golden Hill Road	Highway 46 to Dallons Drive
Paso Robles Street	ramp to 12th Street
River Oaks Drive	North River Road to Buena Vista
Buena Vista Drive	Highway 46 to Dallons Drive
Airport Road	Meadowlark to Pioneer Trail
Meadowlark Road	Creston to Airport
Theatre Drive	in front of Chili's restaurant to City limit
