**NEEDS**: For City Council to consider an allocation from General Fund Reserves for needed repairs.

### FACTS:

- 1. The main natural gas line serving 625 Riverside Avenue has multiple leaks and must be replaced in order to provide heat to the shop and internal buildings.
- 2. The Gas Company terminated service to the facility until replacement lines are installed.
- 3. Natural Gas is the source of heat for the facility.
- 4. Public Works secured three (3) bids for installation of a new customer owned line. Low bid for replacement is \$16,364.

- 5. The 25 year old heating and air conditioning systems at Centennial Park need immediate repair.
- 6. There are eleven units on the administration building and eight units on the gym. The units are actually 'residential units' installed at time of construction. All are well past their life expectancy.
- 7. All units will run in 'cooling mode'. But, six units on the administration building will not work in heat mode or have been taken out of service because of cracked heat exchangers that could allow carbon monoxide to enter the building. Two of the units on the gym are nonoperational. One of the nonoperational unit supplies the heat to the gymnastics room. Presently the YMCA is using quartz heaters for the daycare program.
- 8. The units will need to be replaced when funds are available. The estimated cost for replacement is \$125,000 to \$160,000.
- 9. A short term repair to get through the winter and into spring/summer when a replacement may be more feasible will cost \$14,900.
- 10. Paso Robles Heating and Air were the only bid respondent.

## ANALYSIS &

**CONCLUSION:** Staff has secured bids for the remedial work and can implement repair of both issues immediately should Council allocate the necessary funding from General Fund Reserves. The total cost for repair, including contingency, is \$33,000.

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POLICY

**REFERENCE:** City of Paso Robles Purchasing Procedures.

FISCAL

**IMPACT:** The cost to repair the gas line and HVAC equipment would need to be allocated from the General Fund Reserves.

The Spring 2013 General Fund Financial Forecast projected a Fiscal Year 2014 operating surplus of \$343,000. City Council has already approved use of \$229,000 in FY14. Additionally, \$233,000 of essential repairs must be undertaken this fiscal year. Consequently, approved or essential expenditures already exceed the projected FY14 operating surplus by \$119,000, reducing General Fund Reserves from \$6.4 million to \$6.3 million:

### A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PASO ROBLES ALLOCATING GENERAL FUND RESERVES TO FUND GAS LINE AND HVAC REPAIRS

WHEREAS, the City has determined the natural gas line service at 625 Riverside needs to be replaced; and
