**NEEDS:** 

For the City Council to adopt Resolution 14-XX authorizing a Special Facility Use Agreement with the Estrella Warbirds Museum, Inc. to conduct the 2014 airshow at the Municipal Airport.

FACTS:

- Each year an aviation activity is held whose purpose is to showcase aviation, the 1. municipal airport, and its role as a gateway to the community.
- 2. The Estrella Warbirds Museum, in cooperation with Planes of Fame, an aircraft museum from Chino, CA, has successfully sponsored the past two annual events. This year November 1 is requested as the date of the show.
- 3. A Special Facility Use Agreement between the City and the Museum, authorizing the use of the airport for the event, has been approved for each of the previous years. This agreement is specific to the needs of the airshow event and the requirements and protections of the City. The City Council is requested to authorize execution of a similar agreement for this year's event.
- 4. All other required applications and permits will be issued and in compliance for this event.
- 5. The Airport Advisory Committee recommend City Council approval of the event and the date.

## **ANALYSIS &**

**CONCLUSION:** The airshow event continues to be a time to showcase the airport and aviation. The Museum's partnership with the Planes of Fame organization and their renowned collection of vintage aircraft provides a unique opportunity to accomplish this objective on a much larger scale. The relationship continues to be successful and attract significant interest from the community.
