Dallons Drive
Airport Road
Paso Robles Street
River Oaks Drive
Buena Vista to Jena Court
Meadowlark to Pioneer Trail
US Hwy 101 to 12th Street
South River to Buena Vista

Melody Drive Niblick to Creston

4. Bid documents were prepared and at the bid opening on June 5, 2014 five bids were received as follows:
