**SUBJECT: Street Maintenance — Bid Award**  
DATE: August 5, 2014

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**NEEDS:** For City Council to consider awarding a contract for maintenance repairs of Spring Street from 16th Street to 24th.

- FACTS:**
1. A temporary half-cent sales tax was approved by voters to be used for street maintenance.
  2. On March 5, 2013, City Council identified road segments to be repaired within the first five years of the revenue from the sales tax.
  3. City Council authorized the repair of Spring Street from 16th Street to 24th.
  4. The project was put to bid and at the bid opening July 24, 2014, four bids were received as follows:

Ferravanti Paving & Grading .....	\$ 1,114,299.99
Souza Construction .....	1,185,000.00
Papich Construction .....	1,325,766.84
CalPortland Construction .....	1,375,406.25

**ANALYSIS & CONCLUSION:** Staff reviewed the low bid submitted by Ferravanti and found it to be a responsive and responsible bid. Ferravanti's bid also included work to upgrade deteriorated sewer across 19th and 23rd Streets. It also included bid items to remove and replace deteriorated water valves. The Sewer and Water Enterprise Funds will pay for these work items. To summarize:

Road work items .....	\$ 886,299.99
Sewer items.....	171,150.00
Water items .....	<u>56,850.00</u>
Total	\$ 1,114,299.99

**POLICY REFERENCE:** Resolution No. 13-031 authorizing staff to proceed with the street maintenance plan.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** As of May 2014, \$3,923,528 in sales tax revenue has been received. The Projected Expenditure Plan for the Spring Street project (16th Street to 24th) is \$1,700,000 (see attached).

RESOLUTION NO. 14-xxx

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PASO ROBLES  
AWARDING A CONTRACT MAINTENANCE REPAIRS OF CITY STREETS –  
SPRING STREET, FROM 16TH STREET TO 24TH STREET

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WHEREAS, a temporary half-cent sales tax was approved by voters to be used for street maintenance; and

WHEREAS, on March 5, 2013 City Council adopted Resolution No. 13-031 authorizing staff to proceed with the street maintenance plan, and identifying road segments to be repaired within the first five years of revenue from the sales tax; and

WHEREAS, City Council authorized the repair of Spring Street from 16th Street to 24th; and

WHEREAS, bid documents were prepared and advertised, and at the bid opening July 24, 2014, four bids were received ranging from \$1,114,299.99 to \$1,375,406.25; and

WHEREAS, staff reviewed the low bid submitted by Ferravanti Paving and Grading and found it to be a responsive and responsible bid; and

WHEREAS, the project as awarded to Ferravanti will have funding sources as follows: road work items, \$886,299.99 – Supplemental Sales Tax funds; sewer items, \$171,150 – Sewer Enterprise Funds; and water items, \$56,850 – Water Enterprise Funds; and

WHEREAS, Ferravanti's bid includes work items for sewer (\$171,150) and water (\$56,850); and

WHEREAS, the Sewer and Water Enterprise Funds will pay for these items respectively.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council does hereby appropriate funds as follows: road work items, \$886,299.99 – Supplemental Sales Tax funds; sewer items, \$171,150 – Sewer Enterprise Funds; and water items, \$56,850 – Water Enterprise Funds.

SECTION 2. The City Council does hereby award a contract for maintenance repairs of Spring Street, from 16th Street to 24th Street, to Ferravanti Paving and Grading in the amount of \$1,114,299.99 and authorizes the City Manager to execute the contract.
