Needs: For the City Council to consider appointing resident member to the Housing Authority

Board of Commissioners (the "Board").

1. One of the statutory duties of the City Council is to appoint members of the Board.

- 2. The Board has seven members with three-year staggered terms. Five members may be appointed from the community at large; two members must be residents of Oak Park Public Housing.
- 3. In November 2014, Sherryl Bragg vacated her resident seat. Her term expires February 29, 2016.
- 4. Eloisa Medina, a resident of Oak Park, has submitted an application to serve on the Board.
- 5. Dave Cooke, Executive Director for the Housing Authority, has reported that the Board took action at its meeting of November 18 to recommend that the City Council appoint Ms. Medina to replace Ms. Bragg.

Analysis and Conclusion:

Facts:

A copy of Ms. Medina's resume and application are attached. Ms. Medina will be encouraged to attend the Council meeting on December 16 so that Councilmembers might pose any questions they deem appropriate to the Board seat.
