SUBJECT: San Francisco Giants 2014 World Series Trophy Tour – City Park Event

DATE: December 16, 2014

NEEDS: For the City Council to consider a request by the Paso Robles Police Athletic League to host the San Francisco Giants 2014 World Series Trophy Tour in City Park on February 27, 2015.

FACTS:

1. The Paso Robles Police Athletic League has hosted and operated the San Francisco Giants Junior Giants Youth Baseball Program each summer since 1996. In those 18 years, thousands of children have benefitted from the program, learning sportsmanship and teamwork, while being instructed in baseball basics. More than 200 children participated in Junior Giants in 2014.
2. In November 2014, the Paso Robles Police Athletic League, in recognition of their participation in Junior Giants, was offered the chance to apply for a date on the 2014 World Series Trophy Tour. The application was approved.
3. The World Series Trophy is proposed to be on display in the City Park Gazebo from 5 to 7 p.m. on Friday, February 27, 2015. The Giants will provide fans the opportunity to purchase their own photo taken with the trophy. Per Giants Trophy Tour parameters, the Paso Robles Police Athletic League may ask for a voluntary donation of \$2 from those attending to support and enhance the Junior Giants program. Upwards of 1,500 fans are projected to attend the event.
4. The Giants Trophy Tour Team will be on site for set-up and take down, as well as handing out collateral material.
5. The 2014 World Series Trophy Tour will have no hard cost impact to the City. Media outreach, logistical support and police presence will be provided through normal daily work schedules.

Analysis &

CONCLUSION: When adding events to the City Park schedule, it has been important that those events recognize meaningful community activities and bring positive attention to the City. The San Francisco Giants 2014 World Series Trophy Tour is just such an event. The 2012 Trophy Tour also chose Paso Robles as a display site and the event was very much enjoyed by local and out-of-town attendees.
