Needs: For the City Council to consider setting a date to interview candidates for filling a vacancy on the Paso Robles Housing Authority Board of Commissioners.

1. The Paso Robles Housing Authority was established in the 1940's and is a separate Agency from the City of Paso Robles and is primarily responsible for the operation of the Oak Park Housing Project.

- 2. One of the statutory duties of the Paso Robles City Council is to appoint members to the Board of Commissioners.
- 3. The Board has seven members with three-year staggered terms. Five members may be appointed from the community at large; two members must be residents of Oak Park Public Housing.
- 4. On February 29, 2016, the seat occupied by Shari Goforth will expire. Ms. Goforth has indicated that she will not be applying for reappointment.
- 5. Beginning in January 2016, the City began advertising for applicants for the vacant position. A notice was placed on the City's website and advertisements were placed in the San Luis Obispo Tribune and Paso Robles Press on January 8, 15 and 22nd.
- 6. Potential dates to consider holding Paso Robles Housing Authority Board of Commissioners interviews include Thursday evening, either on February 4th, or 11th.
