- 3. The **Library Board of Trustees** has five members, no alternates, with three-year staggered terms. **There are 2 vacancies**.
- 4. The Senior Citizen Advisory Committee has a maximum of nine members, (7 voting and 2 alternate) with two-year staggered terms. There is one voting-member vacancy.
