**SUBJECT: Award of Contract for Reconstruction of Spring Street – 1<sup>st</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup>**

DATE: March 1, 2016

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**NEEDS:** For City Council to consider awarding a contract for reconstruction of Spring Street from 1<sup>st</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup>.

- FACTS:**
1. The City's Five Year Expenditure Plan for the Supplemental Sales Tax includes Spring Street from 1<sup>st</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup>.
  2. At the bid opening on February 11, 2015, five bids were received as follows:

CalPortland .....	\$ 2,276,089.00
Souza .....	\$ 2,303,000.00
Whitaker.....	\$ 2,317,383.00
Ferravanti .....	\$ 2,520,302.40
Papich .....	\$ 2,745,468.00
  3. The project is expected to be constructed between May and October of 2016. The project work includes water, sewer, storm water, sidewalks, curb ramps, video detection for traffic signals and pavement work.

**ANALYSIS & CONCLUSION:** Staff reviewed the low bid submitted by CalPortland Construction and found it to be a responsive and responsible bid.

**POLICY REFERENCE:** Resolution No. 13-031, which adopted a list of streets to be repaired or reconstructed using revenues from the Supplemental Sales Tax and other sources.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** The Supplemental Sales Tax, General Fund, Water Fund, and Wastewater Fund are the funding sources for this project.

- OPTIONS:**
- a. Award the bid for reconstruction of Spring Street from 1st to 10th, to CalPortland Construction in the amount not to exceed \$2,503,698 (\$2,276,089 contract, plus 10% contingency), and authorize the City Manager to execute the contract.
  - b. Amend, modify, or reject the above option.
