CalRecycle Grant Funding for Beverage Container Recycling SUBJECT:

Needs: For the City Council to acquire a State grant for the local Beverage Container

Recycling efforts, offered through CalRecycle, and administered locally by the

San Luis Obispo County Integrated Waste Management Authority.

Facts: 1. For the past fourteen years the San Luis Obispo County Integrated Waste Management Authority has represented the region in securing State grant funds on our behalf from CalRecycle. CalRecycle has recently changed the rules and requires each jurisdiction to apply for the grant funding and

to then pass through that funding to the regional Authority.

2. CalRecycle requires each City to adopt a resolution for submittal of a grant application, and designation of a Signature Authority.

3. Total funding available for this program is \$10.5 million for FY 2015-16, with the maximum grant for each city capped at \$5,000. Examples of eligible activities include public education, litter prevention and cleanup, cooperative regional efforts, and curbside or drop-off recycling programs.

Analysis &

Conclusion: Beverage containers are a source of litter, and needlessly take up space in the

landfill. This grant program provides funding, without requiring a match, that will allow the City, through the Integrated Waste Management Authority, to

help address beverage container recycling.
