Needs: For the City Council to consider awarding a contract to install pedestrian

improvements at Bauer-Speck Elementary School.

Facts: 1. The City Council adopted a project using CDBG funds to improve pedestrian access at Bauer-Speck Elementary School.

- 2. The improvements are as follows:
  - Bring curb ramps (4 total), at 17<sup>th</sup> Street and at 18<sup>th</sup> (4 total), to meet ADA Standards.
  - Remove and replace existing sidewalk between 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup>, to meet ADA allowed cross slopes, and remove uplifted sidewalks.
  - Remove and replace paving adjacent to the new curb ramps at 17<sup>th</sup> Street.
- 3. City advertised for bids, and at the bid opening on April 21, 2016 (6) bids were received as follows:

Conclusion: Staff reviewed the low bid of \$133,025.00, from JJ Fisher, and found it to be a

responsible and responsive bid.

Impact: The project is being funded with a CDBG Grant. The budget adopted is

\$162,000, which is adequate for the project.

Options: A. Direct the City Manager to enter into a contract with JJ Fisher, in the amount of \$146,328.00 (bid plus 10% contingency), for the pedestrian improvements at the Bauer-Speck Elementary School; or

B. Amend, modify, or reject the above option.
