National Peace Officer Memorial Day
May 15, 2016

National Police Week in Paso Robles
May 15-21, 2016

WHEREAS, *there are more than 900,000 law enforcement officers serving in communities across the United States, including the dedicated members of the Paso Robles Police Department; and*

WHEREAS, *an average of 54,000 assaults against law enforcement officers are reported each year, resulting in an average of 16,000 injuries; and*

WHEREAS, *since the first recorded peace officer death in 1791, more than 19,000 law enforcement officers in the United States have made the ultimate sacrifice and been killed in the line of duty, including one member of the Paso Robles Police Department, David N. Morehouse on May 6, 1919; and*

WHEREAS, *128 peace officers in our nation were killed in the line of duty in 2015 and 7 peace officers were killed in California between May of 2015 and May of 2016, since we last gathered in memoriam of officer line of duty deaths;*

WHEREAS, *the names of these dedicated public servants will be engraved on the walls of the National Law Enforcement Officers Memorial in Washington, D.C. and the California Peace Officer Memorial in Sacramento; and*

WHEREAS, *National Peace Officer Memorial Day (May 15th each year) and National Police Week, May 15 – 21, 2016, was established in 1962 by President John F. Kennedy and a joint resolution of Congress, to pay tribute to the local, State, and Federal law enforcement officers who serve and protect us with courage and dedication; and*

WHEREAS, *the service and sacrifice of all officers killed in the line of duty will be honored during the San Luis Obispo County Criminal Justice Administrators' Association local memorial service, on the morning of Thursday, May 19, 2016, at 10:00 a.m. in Atascadero, CA, at the Faces of Freedom Veterans Memorial.*

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED *that I, Steve Martin, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor, and speaking on behalf of the entire City Council, formally designate May 15, 2016 as National Peace Officer Memorial Day and May 15 - 21, 2016, as National Police Week in Paso Robles, and publicly salute the service of law enforcement officers in our community and in communities across the nation.*
