NEEDS: For City Council to authorize extension of the City's Group Dental and

Vision Insurance Contracts for an additional year.

FACTS: 1. The City's contract with Delta Dental for dental insurance is scheduled to expire on December 31, 2016.

2. The City's contract with California State Association of Counties – Excess Insurance Authority (CSAC-EIA) is scheduled to expire on December 31, 2016.

- 3. All employee labor groups have access to these dental and vision plans per their labor contracts.
- 4. There is no change in the premium renewal rates for either contract for 2017.

## **ANALYSIS &**

CONCLUSION: There is no change in the cost for either the Dental or the Vision Plan

in the coming year. These plans are consistent with the agreed upon

contracts maintained with City employees.
