### 1. Highway 46 East Circulation Issues and Options

The City Council conducted a workshop, with presentations on the history of Highway 46 east, development potential in the City's northeast quadrant, progress to date on the Highway 46/Union Road interchange, and an update of the City's circulation element to reflect progress and plans for the parallel routes and other changes.

Several citizens took advantage of the opportunity to receive the presentations, ask questions, and provide input to the Council.

The Council then provided some initial direction to staff and requested staff return to Council within the next 60 days or so with proposals for moving forward. No substantive decisions were requested or made. The Council requested continued collaboration with SLOCOG; directed staff to develop plans for working with Caltrans to successfully address outstanding issues, and requested that the Housing Constraints and Opportunities Task Force be provided an update and ensure its work on Development Impact Fees is coordinated with these efforts.

ADJOURNMENT. By voice vote, the study session was adjourned at 8:12 p.m.

14. <u>Rezone 16-001: Repeal and Replace Section 21.33 Zoning Ordinance – Regulation of Personal, Medical and Commercial Use of Marijuana</u>

For the City Council to hold a public hearing and consider the creation of a medical marijuana task force, and hold first reading of an ordinance to regulate recreational marijuana use:

**ROLL CALL VOTE #2.** Motion made by Councilman Gregory and seconded by Councilman Hamon to approve Resolution 16-126 finding the Zoning Ordinance amendments are exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") pursuant to Section 15061(b)(3) of the CEQA Guidelines in that there is no possibility that the text amendments would have a potential significant effect on the environment and directs the appropriate City official to file a Notice of Exemption with the County of San Luis Obispo.

- City Manager to enter into a contract with VESTRA for the implementation, migration and training of ESRI GIS Server.
- 5. City Manager to approve "backfill" staffing to assist the implementation of the LMS.

- **6.** City Manager to adjust/amend any and all contracts as further details become evident, for the benefit of the City.
- **7.** City manager to authorize the Information Technology Manager to purchase the necessary software and hardware for the implementation of the LMS.
- **8.** Total project cost not to exceed \$558,000.
