I have served as a legal coach for the Paso Robles High School Mock Trial team and been involved in that program since that program was reinstated in this county in 1998.

I have been active in this county since moving here in June of 1979. I have served on several committees for the Paso Robles Chamber of Commerce and on their Board of Directors twice for double terms in the 1980's. In 1986 until 1992 I served on the North County Council of Camp Fire Board of Directors serving as President for several years. After the merger of the councils that now serve children from Lompoc to Paso Robles, I continued to serve on the Board of Directors for the Camp Fire Council of the Central Coast. Early in 1999, I concluded serving the maximum number of terms on that Board of Directors and he was the President of the Board at that time.

I was one of the primary team members responsible for the formation of a separately chartered United Way for San Luis Obispo County, which included the merger of same with Neighbors- Helping- Neighbors and United Way and I drew up the documents to allow that to happen. This brought about the formation of a single organization to serve the citizens of San Luis Obispo County.

After that merger, I served on the new Board of Directors for many years and was honored as one of the Citizens of the Year by that organization for his part in bringing about the consolidation of Neighbors-Helping-Neighbors and United Way. I continued to serve on that new organization's first Board of Directors until his maximum number of terms expired.

The Economic Opportunity Commission as a part of its Community Action Program selected me as the Board Member of the Year in 1990 for all of my services to non-profit organizations.
