As of January 1, 2017, set field rental fees – regular play- as follows, and annually re-calculate true full-cost recovery to ensure fees keep pace with expenses.

Approve Resolution 16-135 authorizing the following fees:

- a. \$2 per hour for Youth Sports Council member teams with no cap on annual hours of use.
- b. \$3 per hour for youth club teams
- c. \$12 per hour for adult sports teams, moving to \$16 per hour on January 1, 2018.

Amendments: Adding language to clarify fees do not include tournaments with fees to return to the Parks and Recreation Advisory Committee for additional review.
