**Subject**: Award 2016 Annual Sidewalk Repair Project

Date: December 20, 2016

#### **Facts**

- 1. Sidewalks are a very important part of the transportation system, and are key for many residents to be able to go shopping or receive services. Repair of uneven sidewalk improves pedestrian safety and reduces liability.
- 2. The City Council adopted a budget to repair City sidewalks. The City did a sidewalk inspection and repair project earlier this year using \$26,000 in grant funds from CJPIA (the City's insurance provider). The focus of that effort was the downtown, and on sidewalk deviations that were less than two inches. The larger deviations from that effort, and others around the community, are the ones included in this proposed Sidewalk Repair project.
- 3. Staff prepared bid documents and advertised for bids on November 7, 2016, with the repair work expected to be completed in the spring and summer.
- 4. A total of 4 bids were received and opened on December 8, 2016, ranging from \$65,760 to \$99,103 as follows:

CalPortland Construction - \$65,760.00 S. Chaves Construction - \$67,147.10 Souza Construction \$68,250.00 R. Burke Construction \$99,103.00

#### **Options**

- 1. Do nothing:
- 2. Award construction contract for the work to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder;
- 3. Amend, modify or reject Option 2.

#### **Analysis and Conclusions**

- 1. If the City does nothing, the sidewalks will remain uneven and pedestrian concerns will not be addressed.
- 2. Staff reviewed the low bid of \$65,760 from CalPortland Construction and found it to be a responsive and responsible bid. The following nine locations are on the contract:

905 Vine Street
530 10<sup>th</sup> Street
901 Turtle Creek Drive
2940 Spring Street
2315 Oak Street
2325 Oak Street
1716 Kings Drive
2325 Oak Street

## **Fiscal Impact**

The two-year budget allocated \$100,000 for sidewalk repairs of uneven City sidewalks. It is currently anticipated that remaining funds will be used to advertise for bids for a new list of repairs to be completed in the third quarter of 2017.

## Recommendation

- Authorize the City Manager to enter into an agreement with CalPortland Construction in the amount of \$72,336 (\$65,760 + 10% contingency), to perform sidewalk repairs at the locations noted above.
   Authorize the City Manager and City Attorney to make minor adjustments to the agreements, if needed,
- 2. Authorize the City Manager and City Attorney to make minor adjustments to the agreements, if needed remaining fully consistent with the Council's intent.

Bidders must provide pricing for every bid item with quantity greater than zero.

The estimated quantities for unit price items are for purposes of comparing bids only and City makes no representation that the actual quantities of work performed will not vary from the estimates.

In case of discrepancy between the unit price and the line item cost set forth for a unit price item, the line item cost, calculated at the unit price multiplied by the estimated quantity, shall prevail and shall be utilized as the basis for determining the lowest responsive, responsible bidder. However, if the amount set forth as a unit price is ambiguous, unintelligible or uncertain for any cause, or is omitted, or is the same amount as the entry in the "Line Item Cost" column, then the amount set forth in the "Line Item Cost" column for the item shall prevail and shall be divided by the estimated quantity for the item and the price thus obtained shall be the unit price. If any of the above discrepancies exist, City may recalculate the bid price on the basis of the unit price and the bidder agrees to be bound by such recalculation. Final payment for unit price items shall be determined by City from measured quantities of work performed.
