- 1. Approve Resolution No. 17-021 approving a request to submit applications to:
 - **a.** Initiate the process of amending the General Plan to split the Chandler Ranch Specific Plan Area into two separate specific plans;
 - **b.** Allocate residential density units for the two specific plan areas; and
- 2. Begin the process of a South Chandler Ranch specific plan with a public participation process including establishment of a City Council / Planning Commission Ad Hoc Committee.

13. <u>Memorandum of Agreement with the County of San Luis Obispo to Jointly Finance and Construct a</u> <u>Replacement Animal Services Shelter</u>

Motion made by Councilman Hamon and seconded by Councilman Strong to approve Resolution No. 17-022, authorizing the City Manager to execute a memorandum of agreement in substantial conformance with the County of San Luis Obispo, and the Cities of Arroyo Grande, Atascadero, Grover Beach, Morro Bay, and Pismo Beach, to jointly finance and construct the replacement of an animal services shelter. Motion was amended to stipulate Councilman Reed be added as Steering Committee member.

9. Recruitment of Fire Chief and Battalion Chief

ROLL CALL VOTE. Motion made by Councilman Hamon and seconded by Councilman Gregory to:

- Approve Resolution No. 17-023 appointing Phillip Garcia as Interim Fire Chief and Chris Slate as Interim Battalion Chief, thus authorizing the City Manager to enter into agreements for which each will work staggered 40-hour shifts to ensure all 7 days of the week can be covered, as needed; and provide for temporary out-of-class promotions for three of the six captains, to serve as Acting Battalion Chiefs, on rotational shift duty, providing 24-hour coverage.
- 2. Appropriate \$112,500 from reserves for the remaining 4+ months of Fiscal Year 2016-17, and \$75,000 for Fiscal Year 2017-18.
