Subject: Sports Field Netting Installation at Barney Schwartz Park
Date: May 2, 2017

Facts

1. Barney Schwartz Park (BSP) amenities include two playgrounds, a lake, four softball fields, four soccer fields, BBQ pavilions and concession stands.
2. Softball Fields #1, #2 and #3 measure 300' from home plate to the outfield fence. Softball Field #4 measures 270' from home plate to the outfield fence. Softball Field #4 is directly adjacent to Soccer Field #2 and occasionally softballs/baseballs fly into the soccer area.
3. The Paso Robles REC Foundation, through its Dale Schwartz Memorial Endowment Fund for Barney Schwartz Park, has voted to fund installation of protective sports field netting on the Softball Field #4 outfield fence. This non-profit foundation has previously funded a BBQ pavilion, shade structures, trail mile markers, lighting maintenance, parking lot paving and the upcoming lower playground replacement at BSP. The group is a key supporter of community-wide recreation efforts including the replacement of the City Park playground, Centennial Pool reopening, Salinas River Corridor, Sherwood Park playground, Sherwood Dog Park, Municipal Pool and Centennial Pool shade structures and many more recreation-enhancing projects in Paso Robles.
4. Bid documents for Softball Field #4 sports field netting were prepared and advertised for bid on February 21, 2017.
5. Bids were received and opened on April 6, 2017 as follows:

West Coast Netting Construction Services	\$24,000
Judge Netting, Inc.	\$34,200

Options

1. Do nothing.
2. Award a contract for sports field netting to West Coast Netting Construction Services.
3. Direct staff to pursue a different approach.

Analysis and Conclusions

BSP is the premier sports park in Paso Robles. The softball fields are used by both youth and adult teams from January through November. The soccer fields are in high demand and fully programmed from June through February. Installation of sports field netting will provide a needed safety enhancement to the park and allow for flexible scheduling of field use when both sports are active. REC Foundation has voted the project a priority to be funded through their Dale Schwartz Memorial Endowment Fund for Barney Schwartz Park.

Staff reviewed the low bid from West Coast Netting Construction Services and found it to be a responsive and responsible bid.

Fiscal Impact

The City will not experience any financial impact as a result of this project.

Recommendation

1. Authorize the City Manager to enter into an agreement with West Coast Netting Construction Services for Barney Schwartz Park Sports Field Netting in the amount of \$24,000.
2. Authorize the City Manager and City Attorney to make minor adjustments to the agreement, if needed, remaining fully consistent with the Council's intent.

In case of discrepancy between the Unit Price and the Item Cost set forth for a unit basis item, the unit price shall prevail and shall be utilized as the basis for determining the lowest responsive, responsible Bidder.
