Subject: Tree Trimming on Riverglen Drive

Facts

- 1. The El Paso de Robles Landscape and Lighting Maintenance District No. 1 installs and maintains neighborhood improvements for over 4,000 parcels across the City by way of an annual property owner assessment. These improvements are defined as landscaping in parkways, medians and open space; public lighting; and services related to these broad categories including irrigation and landscape lighting.
- 2. Landscape and Lighting Zone 1, Sub Areas 1, 4, 6, 18, 19, 47, 51, 55, 56, 58, 69A, 69B, 69C, 69D, 91, 114 and 115 is comprised of residential subdivisions and properties generally located on the north side of Union Road and east of North River Road. Riverglen Drive traverses through Zone 1 from Union Road to Skyview Drive.
- 3. Staff has identified the trees on Riverglen Drive as requiring trimming. Bid documents for Tree Trimming on Riverglen Drive were prepared and advertised for bid on March 13, 2017.
- 4. Bids were received and opened on April 20, 2017 as follows:

West Coast Arborists \$32,875 A & T Arborists \$62,100

Options

- 1. Do nothing.
- 2. Award a contract for tree trimming to West Coast Arborists.
- 3. Direct staff to pursue a different approach.

Analysis and Conclusions

The trees on Riverglen Drive have been identified as requiring trimming to improve structural strength, mitigate existing pest problems, maintain aesthetic characteristics, and provide clearance for pedestrians, vehicles and structures. Further, the contractor is obligated to provide for the on-site supervision of a certified arborist.

Staff reviewed the low bid from West Coast Arborists and found it to be responsive and responsible.

Fiscal Impact

Zone 1 Landscape and Lighting District Assessments will fund tree-trimming services. There will be no impact to the General Fund.

Recommendation

- 1. Authorize the City Manager to enter into an agreement with West Coast Arborists for Tree Trimming on Riverglen Drive in the amount of \$32,875.
- 2. Authorize the City Manager and City Attorney to make minor adjustments to the agreement, if needed, remaining fully consistent with the Council's intent.


