City Council attended a mobile tour to:

1. Review the alternative locations and feasibility plans for the proposed Huer Huero Creek Bridge project.
2. Provide direction to staff on the preferred location for the Huer Huero Creek Bridge, which will be incorporated into Circulation Element update process.

Council toured three locations for the proposed Huer Huero Creek Bridge options. At the conclusion of their tour, Council reconvened in the Council Chambers at 3:22 to vote on the preferred Huer Huero Creek bridge options.

1. Motion was made by Councilman Gregory, and seconded by Councilman Strong, and approved unanimously to recommend a North Bridge location with a roundabout intersection at Airport Road and "Erskine Parkway", as the Huer Huero Creek Bridge project
2. Motion was made by Councilman Gregory, seconded by Councilman Strong, and passed unanimously to direct staff to pursue an interim signal light at SR 46E / Union Road while continuing with the Caltrans PAED process.

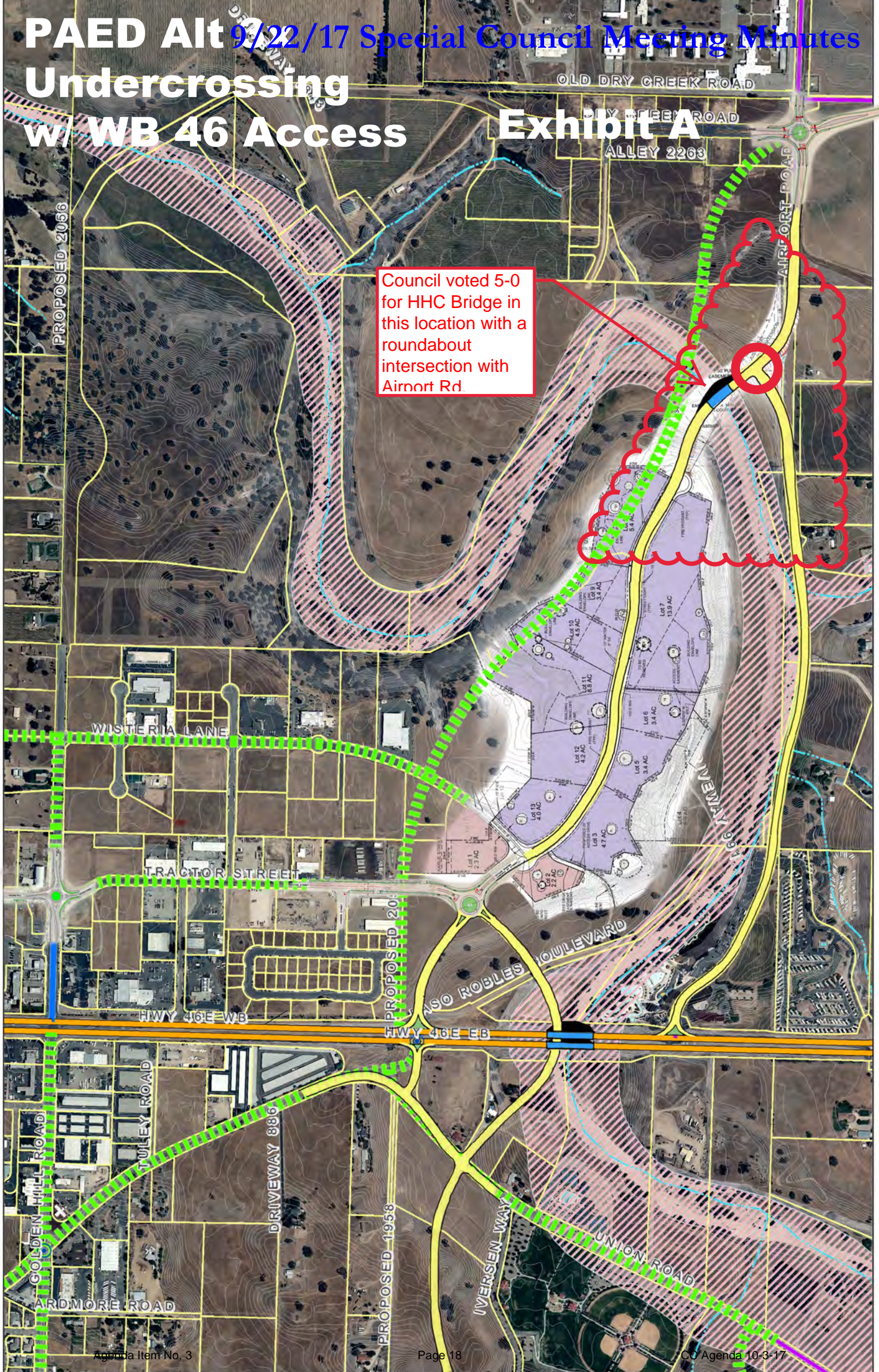
