CONSENT AGENDA

 Meeting Minutes – A motion by Mr. Gaspar, seconded by Mr. Nunno, to approve the Consent Agenda as presented, passes unanimously. The agenda consists of the minutes of the August 24, 2017, Regular Meeting.

DISCUSSION ITEMS

2. Airport Appreciation Day

The commission received reports from staff and from Tony Gaspar, Chairman of the AirFest event regarding the successes and accomplishments of the annual Airport Appreciation Day. It is agreed that the temperature of the day impacted the attendance somewhat. The Commission was complimentary and appreciative of the many volunteers who worked make this event become reality.

3. Commission Work Plan

The Commission reviews a list of possible tasks requiring their effort. Procedures for developing the work product are discussed. It is agreed that a next project should be to review and update the airport Minimum Standards document in the same manner as the recently completed Airport Leasing Policy and the Airport Regulations. The process will require staff to revise and present a first draft of the document to an assigned sub-committee. Their finished review draft will then be forwarded to the full commission for consideration and recommendation to the City Council for approval. Commissioners Caskey, Culver and Marshall agreed to serve as the review sub-committee. Staff will schedule their meeting once the first draft is complete.

Further discussion centers on Airport marketing and development. It is necessary to develop strategies as well as define the available target areas to focus upon. The effort should follow similar marketing strategies in play, elsewhere in the City. It is suggested that key City staff involved in these programs could provide useful direction to the commission for their effort. The commission requests Mr. Frutchey and Mr. Frace be invited to the next meeting to share their insights on current City marketing efforts.

DIRECTOR/MANAGER UPDATES

4. Airport Leases

Staff reports on the effort to provide completed, long-term lease agreements with those tenants affected by the Airport Lease Policy changes. All have been approved by the City Council and the last are being executed now. The City's effort to engaged the services of real estate professionals in leasing and disposing of various City properties and how these resources can assist in airport marketing is discussed. No action is taken.

5. Airport Construction

The commission reviews the list of airport construction projects that have recently been completed. The list includes the major taxiway rehabilitation project, as well as smaller repair and improvement projects. Mr. Gaspar asks about the possibility of repainting the 'Paso Robles' label on the main apron. Staff will research. Outside projects, including the shoulder backing on Airport Road and adjacent streets, are noted. No action is taken.

6. Airport Regulation Implementation

The commission received a report on the efforts to bring private hangar occupancies into compliance, including a hanger clean-up day scheduled in October, as well as individual hangar inspections. Enforcement criteria for hangar content is discussed. No action is taken.

7. Special Events Update

With the completion of the final special event of the season, the commission reviews the effectiveness and accomplishments of the various events. There is discussion of the need to plan and organize these events more in advance. The amount of volunteer labor needed to implement each of these events is an essential consideration in the planning phases. No action is taken.
