PASO ROBLES CITY COUNCIL  
APRIL 2, 1985

The City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles, meeting in regular session on the above date, was called to order by Mayor Gary Stemper at 7:30 P.M. in the City Council Chambers with the following Councilpersons answering roll call: Cousins, Ovitt, Russell, Thorndyke and Stemper; none being absent. Before roll call, Reverend Charles Culbreath gave a brief invocation.

1. The minutes of the regular meeting of March 19, 1985 and the adjourned meeting of March 25, 1985 were presented and upon motion by Councilman Russell, seconded by Councilman Thorndyke and passed unanimously, the minutes were approved with the following corrections to the minutes of March 19, 1985: Item 18 - Resolution No. 2993 - Mayor Stemper abstained in the motion to read the resolution by title only and in the motion to adopt Resolution No. 2993.

2. It was moved by Councilman Russell and seconded by Councilman Ovitt that the following claims be paid from their respective accounts:

4. Ordinance No. 498 N.S. AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING PAYMENT OF FEE TO DEFRAY COST OF CONSTRUCTING BRIDGES AND INCIDENTS THEREOF, is presented for second reading and adoption.
