

MINUTES OF THE ADJOURNED MEETING
PASO ROBLES CITY COUNCIL
NOVEMBER 13, 1985

The City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles, meeting in adjourned session on the above date, was called to order by Mayor Gary Stemper at 6:00 P.M. in the Senior Citizens Center with the following Councilpersons answering roll call: Cousins, Ovitt, Russell, and Stemper; Councilman Thorndyke being absent.

1. Ms. Pat Johnson, President of the Library Board, presented a brief review of the status of the Library expansion at this time.
2. Members of ACORN appeared and expressed opinions regarding the expansion of the Library. The group President, Rose Monroe, said ACORN could not support the relocation proposed by the Library Board. There was continued discussion on this matter.
3. Councilman Russell recommended that the City proceed with modification of the Boatman Building, excluding the exterior modification, allocating additional funds, of \$100,000, from the Council Contingency budget. There was further discussion of the recommendation; however, no decision was reached.
4. Motion by Councilman Ovitt, seconded by Councilman Russell and passed unanimously to adjourn.
