MINUTES OF THE ADJOURNED REGULAR MEETING/STUDY SESSION
PASO ROBLES CITY COUNCIL
AUGUST 7, 1989

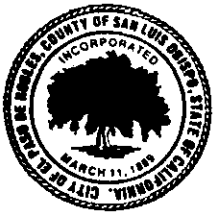
The City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles, meeting in adjourned regular session at 6:30 p.m. on the above date, was called to order by Mayor Steve Martin with the following Councilmen answering roll call: Conway, Russell and Martin; Councilman Dolan being absent; one vacancy existing.

1. The City Council conducted interviews of the applicants for the Library Board of Trustees and one vacancy on the Planning Commission.
2. The Building Official, Doug Monn, reported on the proposed Ordinance revisions and major provisions of the 1988 Uniform Building Code. The City Council discussed and raised questions to the purpose and content of some of the revisions. No action was taken.
3. The Director of Community Development, Bob Lata, presented the request for the following changes to street names: Golden Hill/Pioneer; Beechwood/Rhombic; Nicklaus/Lilac. The City Council, through discussion, indicated the issue of Golden Hill and Pioneer to be one warranting further discussion. The City Council, through discussion, directed staff to proceed with Beechwood/Rhombic and Nicklaus/Lilac changes, all three to be scheduled for public hearing in the next Council meeting.
4. The Director of Community Development, Bob Lata, presented an outline of various studies as factors in the development of the Land Use Element. He updated the City Council on the calendar leading to final adoption, including environmental certifications by Fall, 1990.
5. The City Manager reported to the City Council on the need to repower Fire Engine # 209 and advised the Council of staffs' proceeding with obtaining bids for City Council consideration at the Council meeting of August 15, 1989.
6. The City Manager reported to the City Council the discovery of illegal dumping on the City's Municipal Airport and the hiring of a hazardous materials hauler for removal and clean up. He advised the City Council of an Environmental Health Department investigation on the source of the hazardous material. It was reported that the site contained seven (7) illegally dumped 55 gallon drums containing crank case oil and, approximately 40 gallons of aviation fuel.
7. There were no Council comments.
8. During public comments, Mrs. Snow, a resident of the Jardine Road area, presented pictures of the dump and asked the City Council's quick action at removal and determination of the level of possible soils contamination. Mr. Snow also spoke, questioning why the barrels had been unnoticed by City staff. There were no further comments.

9. There being no further business, it was moved by Councilman Conway, seconded by Councilman Russell and passed unanimously to adjourn to August 14, 1989 at 7:00 p.m. in the City Council Chambers.
