MINUTES OF THE ADJOURNED REGULAR MEETING  
PASO ROBLES CITY COUNCIL  
SEPTEMBER 11, 1989

The City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles, meeting in regular session at 7:00 p.m. on the above date, was called to order by Mayor Steve Martin with the following Councilmembers answering roll call: Conway, Dolan, Russell, and Martin; none being absent and one vacancy existing.

1. The Mayor announced that it was the time and place scheduled for public hearing of Resolution No. RA 89-11, AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. RA 89-04 TO CHANGE THE GEOGRAPHICAL BOUNDARIES OF SUB-AREA "A". Staff explained that adoption of Resolution No. RA 89-11, amended the area subject to Sub-Area A Standard for Development to extend from 8th to 11th Street and Spring to Pine Street

After discussion, it was moved by Councilman Dolan and seconded by Councilman Conway to approve the amendment to Sub-Area "A" as contained in Resolution No. RA 89-11 and direct staff to apply the adopted Standard for Development to any City Park improvements.. Motion passed unanimously.

2. The Chandler Ranch Specific Plan Environmental Impact Report/Request For Proposals was presented to the Council for discussion of land use alternatives to be made a part of the Environmental Review.

3. The Fuselage Way Road alignment from Taxiway "C" north to Rollie Gates Drive was presented for approval and direction to initiate the necessary lotline adjustments to Parcels 20, 21, 22-A, 17-A and 19. Following discussion, it was moved by Councilman Dolan, seconded by Councilman Conway and passed by a three to one vote (Councilman Russell dissenting) to approve an "S" curve alignment as extension of Wing Way from Rollie Gates Drive to Taxiway "C".

4. The matter of the Planning Commission adoption of City Policy in regard to street improvements was presented for Council discussion. Motion by Councilman Dolan, seconded by Councilman Conway and passed unanimously tooi receive request but take no action to change present prpcedure.

5. There were no public comments.

6. There being no further business, it was moved by Councilman Russell, seconded by Councilman Dolan and passed unanimously to adjourn.
