After listening to options and recommendations by staff and hearing public testimony, Council achieved consensus on the following points: (1) approval of overnight security personnel at the park from 10:00 PM to 6:00 AM; (2) adjustment of fees for park facilities from current levels to rates more comparable to other area facilities; (3) posting "no swimming" notice at the park lake; (4) opening the park for softball, baseball and general use in June 2002, and September 2002 for football and soccer; and (5) directing staff to return to Council for further discussion regarding operation of concession stands.

Council, by general consensus, adjourned from regular session at 10:45 PM.
