

ORDINANCE NO. 101 N.S.

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE BONDS AND SALARIES OF CERTAIN OFFICERS OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES, AND REPEALING ORDINANCES NUMBERED 20 N.S., 57 N.S. and 66 N.S.

The City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles, does ordain as follows;

Section 1. The several officers herein named shall, before entering upon the discharge of the duties of their respective offices, give a corporate surety bond to the City of El Paso de Robles, signed by the principal and a corporate surety authorized to do business in the State of California and conditioned according to law, as follows, to-wit:

The City Clerk and ex-officio Assessor, in the sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00).

The Treasurer, in the sum of Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30,000.00).

The Tax and License Collector, in the sum of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00).

The City Recorder, in the sum of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00).

Section 2. If, in the opinion of the City Council of this City, the bond of any officer shall become insufficient for any cause, the said City Council may, by resolution, require another or an additional bond to be given, and if not given within five days (5) after notice to the principal that such other or additional bond is required, the office held by such person shall be declared vacant.

Section 3. Each officer hereinafter specified shall receive, as salary or compensation for the duties of the office held by him, the following:

The City Clerk and ex-officio Assessor shall receive \$75.00 per month.

The City Treasurer shall receive \$30.00 per month.


The City Tax and License Collector, City Marshall, City Recorder, City Attorney, the Superintendent of Streets and all other officers and employees of the City, shall receive the amounts now being paid to them for their services, but these amounts may be changed from time to time by resolution of the City Council, or by motion duly entered on

the minutes of the City Council; provided, that the City Attorney shall receive for such services as he may render in the Superior, Appellate or Supreme Court, a reasonable fee for services so rendered, in addition to his monthly compensation.

Section 4. Said salaries shall be paid monthly, unless the City Council shall, by resolution, otherwise direct.

Section 5. Ordinance No. 20 N.S. passed on the 19th day of May, 1924, entitled "An Ordinance Fixing the Bonds and Salaries of Certain Officers of the City of El Paso de Robles", Ordinance No. 57 N.S. passed on the 3rd day of February, 1936, entitled "An Ordinance Amending Ordinance No. 20, New Series, Entitled 'An Ordinance Fixing the Bonds and Salaries of Certain Officers of the City of El Paso de Robles and Repealing Ordinance No. 178' Passed on the 19th day of May, 1924," and Ordinance No. 66 N.S. passed on the 7th day of February, 1938, entitled "An Ordinance Amending Ordinance No. 20 N.S. Fixing the Bonds and Salaries of Certain Officers" are hereby repealed.

The foregoing ordinance is hereby approved after passage this 21st day of December, 1942.


