

ORDINANCE NO. 142 N.S.

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING AND ESTABLISHING CERTAIN
STREET GRADES IN THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES

The City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles does
ordain as follows:

Section 1. That whereas the City Council of the City of
El Paso de Robles, did on the 2nd day of May, 1949, pass a resolution
entitled "A Resolution of Intention to Change and Establish the Grade
of a Portion of Spring Street in the City of El Paso de Robles," and

WHEREAS, said Resolution of Intention did state the name of
the street, the grades of which or any portion thereof, was proposed
to be changed or established, and did also set forth the grade to be
changed or established; and

WHEREAS, said Resolution of Intention was immediately posted
conspicuously, after passage, for two days near the chamber door of
said City Council, and was published for two insertions in a news-
paper published and circulated in said city and designated by said
City Council for that purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Street Superintendent of said City did there-
upon cause to be conspicuously posted along the street or portion
thereof designated in said Resolution of Intention, where such change
or establishment of grade is proposed to be made, notices of the passage
of said Resolution of Intention. Said notice was headed "Notice of Change
of Grade" in letters of not less than one inch in length, and did in
legible characters state the fact of the passage of said Resolution
of Intention, its date, the name of the public street, or portion
thereof, the grade of which it is proposed to change or establish, and
did refer to said Resolution of Intention for further particulars; and

WHEREAS, said Street Superintendent did also cause a notice
similar in substance to be published by two insertions in a newspaper
published and circulated in said city and designated by the City
Council for that purpose.

Section 2. WHEREAS, no protests were filed against said proposed change or establishment of grades, and now, therefore, it is hereby ordered that the grades on the street and portion of Spring Street hereinafter designated be and the same are hereby established at the following elevations, to-wit:

At the intersection with First Street, the grade shall be 762.2 feet at the northwest and northeast corners.

At a point on the westerly side thereof 140 feet North of the North line of First Street, the grade shall be 763.8 feet and 763.6 feet on the easterly side opposite thereto.

At the intersection of Second Street, the grade shall be 764.8 feet at the southwest corner, and 764.4 feet on the east side opposite thereto.

At the northwest corner the grade shall be 765.1 feet, and 764.6 feet on the east side opposite thereto.

At a point on the west side 80 feet north of the north line of Second Street, the grade shall be 764.9 feet and 765.0 feet on the east side opposite thereto.

At a point on the west side 130 feet north of the north line of Second Street, the grade shall be 764.8 feet and 764.8 feet on the east side opposite thereto.

At a point on the west side 180 feet north of the north line of Second Street, the grade shall be 764.4 feet and 764.4 feet on the east side opposite thereto.

At a point on the west side 230 feet north of the north line of Second Street, the grade shall be 763.5 feet and 763.5 feet on the east side opposite thereto.

At the intersection of Third Street, the grade shall be 761.3 feet at the southwest corner and 761.5 feet on the east side opposite thereto.

At the northwest corner, the grade shall be 759.0 feet, and 759.2 feet on the east side opposite thereto.

At a point on the west side 120 feet north of the north line of Third Street, the grade shall be 753.5 feet, and 753.5 feet on the

east side opposite thereto.

At the intersection with Fourth Street, the grade shall be 744.0 feet at the southwest and southeast corners, and 741.1 feet at the northwest and northeast corners.

At a point on the westerly side 50 feet north from the north line of Fourth Street, the grade shall be 739.8 feet and 739.5 feet on the east side opposite thereto.

At a point on the west side 100 feet north from the north line of Fourth Street, the grade shall be 738.7 feet, and 738.3 feet on the east side opposite thereto.

At a point on the west side 150 feet north from the north line of Fourth Street, the grade shall be 738.3 feet, and 737.8 feet on the east side opposite thereto.

At the intersection with Fifth Street, the grade shall be 738.0 feet at the southwest corner, and 737.5 feet on the east side opposite thereto.

At the northwest corner, the grade shall be 738.2 feet, and 737.5 feet on the east side opposite thereto.

At the intersection with Sixth Street, the grade shall be 739.7 feet at the southwest and southeast corners, and 740.0 feet at the northwest and northeast corners.

At the intersection with Seventh Street, the grade shall be 740.8 feet at the southwest and northwest corners, and 740.6 feet at the southeast and northeast corners.

At the intersection with Eighth Street, the grade shall be 740.0 feet at the southwest and southeast corners, and 740.5 feet at the northwest and northeast corners.

At the intersection with Ninth Street, the grade shall be 741.5 feet at the southwest corner and 741.0 feet at the southeast corner.

Section 3. At all points between said designated points, the grade shall be established so as to conform to a straight line drawn between said designated points.


Elevations herein given are in feet and hundredths of a foot

above City Datum Plane, theretofore established, and refer to the top of the curb on each side of the street.

Any corner hereinbefore referred to relates to a point where a line drawn perpendicularly to the boundary line of said Spring Street from the intersection of said boundary with the boundary line of any intersecting street intersects the curb line of said Spring Street.


Section 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

The foregoing ordinance is hereby approved after passage this 20th day of June, 1949.
