

ORDINANCE NO. 167 N.S.

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING AND ESTABLISHING CERTAIN
STREET GRADES IN THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES

The City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That whereas the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles, did on the 5th day of November, 1951, pass a resolution entitled "A Resolution of Intention to change and establish official grades on portions of certain Streets in the City of El Paso de Robles," and

WHEREAS, said Resolution of Intention did state the name of each of the streets, the grades of which or any portion thereof, was proposed to be changed or established, and did also set forth the grade to be changed or established and

WHEREAS, said Resolution of Intention was immediately posted conspicuously, after passage, for two days near the chamber door of said City Council, and was published for two insertions in a newspaper published and circulated in said city and designated by said City Council for that purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Street Superintendent of said city did thereupon cause to be conspicuously posted along all public streets or portions thereof designated in said Resolution of Intention, where such change or establishment of grade proposed to be made, notices of the passage of said Resolution of Intention. Said notice was headed "Notice of Change of Grade" in letters of not less than one inch in length, and did in legible characters state the fact of the passage of said Resolution of Intention, its date, the name of the public streets, or portions thereof, the grade of which it is proposed to change or establish, and did refer to said Resolution of Intention for further particulars; and

WHEREAS, said Street Superintendent did also cause a notice similar in substance to be published by two insertions in a newspaper published and circulated in said city and designated by the City Council for that purpose.

Section 2. WHEREAS, only one protest having been filed and unanimously overruled after hearing by the City Council, it is hereby ordered that the grades on the streets and portions of streets hereinafter designated be and the same are hereby established as shown on the following plans, profiles and cross sections which are on file in the office of the City Clerk in said city:

"Plan and Profile No. 106, Vine Street Improvement from 1st Street to 4th Street" and "Cross-Sections, Vine Street from 1st Street to 4th Street."

"Plan and Profile No. 107, Oak Street Improvement from 1st Street to 3rd Street" and "Cross-Sections, Oak Street from 1st Street to 3rd Street."

"Plan and Profile No. 108, Olive Street Improvement from 1st Street to 3rd Street" and "Cross-Sections, Olive Street from 1st Street to 3rd Street."

"Plan and Profile No. 109, 1st Street Improvement from Spring Street to Vine Street" and "Cross-Sections, 1st Street from Spring Street to Vine Street."

"Plan and Profile No. 110, 2nd Street Improvement from Spring Street to Olive Street" and "Cross-Sections, 2nd Street from Spring Street to Olive Street."


"Plan and Profile No. 111, 3rd Street Improvement from Spring Street to Olive Street" and "Cross-Sections, 3rd Street from Spring Street to Olive Street."

The elevations of the grades to be established are shown and delineated on the above plans, profiles and cross-sections in feet and decimals of a foot. The figures following the designation of grade points indicate the number of feet that such points are above sea level, and are fixed and established with reference to a common datum plane and standard bench mark consisting of the top of a brass bolt set in the nosing of the cast iron sill of the building at the Northeast corner of Twelfth and Spring Streets in said City, the said datum plane and standard bench mark being at

the elevation of 738.60 feet above sea level.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

The foregoing ordinance is hereby approved after passage this 21st day of January, 1952.


