

the hour of Eight o'clock P. M. of said date, at the Council Chamber in the City Hall, in the City of El Paso de Robles, County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, as the time and place when and where any person owning real property within which said territory so proposed to be annexed and having any objection to the proposed annexation might appear before the City Council and show cause why such territory should not be so annexed or might file written protest against the proposed annexation; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles is acting upon said petition for annexation under the provisions of an act of the Legislature of the State of California entitled "Annexation of Uninhabited Territory Act of 1939, As Amended"; and

WHEREAS, the City Clerk of the City of El Paso de Robles has caused a copy of said Resolution to be published for the time, in the form and manner as required by law, as appears from the affidavit of publication of said Resolution on file with the City Clerk of said City; and

WHEREAS, The City Clerk of the City of El Paso de Robles caused written notice of time and place of hearing protests of said annexation to be mailed to all owners of real property lying within said territory, and said notice was mailed in the time, form and manner as required by the Government Code, as amended, as appears from the affidavit of mailing of said notice on file with the City Clerk of said City; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing has been had on said proposed annexation as so noticed, and no protest or objection having been made to said proposed annexation by any owner of property within the territory proposed to be annexed, by the filing of a written protest or otherwise, or at all;

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES

DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: That said City Council does hereby approve the annexation to the City of El Paso de Robles as "Annexation No. Three" of the uninhabited territory contiguous to the City of El Paso de Robles, situate in the County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, and described as follows:

That portion of Lot 15 of the Rancho Santa Ysabel in the County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, as shown upon the map of the Subdivisions of the Rancho Santa Ysabel and adjacent lands, surveyed by R. R. Harris, C. E., in October of 1886 and filed for record on January 25, 1887, in the office of the County Recorder of said County and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at Post S. Y. 112 in the center of old San Luis Obispo County Road No. 91, thence running North $50^{\circ} 45'$ West along said center line 225.00 feet to true point of beginning; thence leaving said center line and running the following courses and distances, South $39^{\circ} 15'$ West 168.00 feet to a point; thence South $17^{\circ} 29'$ West 782.93 feet; thence North $75^{\circ} 32'$ West 28.20 feet; thence North $72^{\circ} 32'$ West 1055.60 feet to a point; thence North $66^{\circ} 05'$ West 177.75 feet; thence North $48^{\circ} 08'$ West 65.59 feet to a 36" diameter white Oak thence North $5^{\circ} 19'$ West 1052.08 feet to a 20" diameter white Oak; thence North $71^{\circ} 12'$ West 658.15 feet to a point; thence North $4^{\circ} 22'$ East 313.70 feet to a point in the center line of said Old County Road No. 91; thence North $85^{\circ} 25'$ East 817.08 feet along said center line to S. Y. 111; thence South $50^{\circ} 45'$ East along said center line 1897.60 feet to the true point of beginning, containing 54.493 acres.

SECTION 2: That the City Clerk of this City, being the Ex-Officio Clerk of this City Council, promptly upon this Ordinance becoming effective, prepare under the Seal of the City of El Paso de Robles, a certified copy of this Ordinance, giving the date of its passage, and transmit it to the Secretary of State.


SECTION 3: This ordinance is an ordinance affecting the public peace, health and safety and shall be in full force and effect immediately upon adoption thereof. The facts constituting the urgency are as follows:

The Paso Robles area has been declared a critical defense area and the construction of homes is urgently required to fill the needs of the military and civilian per-

sonnel of Camp Roberts, California. The immediate annexation of the above described land will permit the more rapid subdivision thereof and construction of homes thereon.


