

ORDINANCE NO. 237 N.S.

AN ORDINANCE CALLING A SPECIAL ELECTION IN THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE ELECTORS OF SAID CITY A PROPOSITION OF INCURRING A BONDED INDEBTEDNESS OF SAID CITY FOR THE ACQUISITION AND CONSTRUCTION AND COMPLETION OF A MUNICIPAL IMPROVEMENT; DECLARING THE ESTIMATED COST OF SAID IMPROVEMENT, THE AMOUNT OF THE PRINCIPAL OF SAID INDEBTEDNESS TO BE INCURRED THEREFOR, AND THE MAXIMUM RATE OF INTEREST TO BE PAID THEREON; AND FIXING THE DATE AND THE MANNER OF HOLDING OF SAID ELECTION, AND PROVIDING FOR NOTICE THEREOF.

The City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles does ordain as follows:

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles by resolution passed and adopted at a regular meeting of said Council on August 29, 1960, by the affirmative vote of more than two-thirds of all of its members, did determine that the public interest and necessity demanded the acquisition and construction and completion of the municipal improvement hereinafter mentioned, and did further determine that the cost of said proposed municipal improvement will be too great to be paid out of the ordinary annual income and revenue of said City;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, as follows:

1. A special municipal election be, and is hereby, called and ordered and will be held in the City of El Paso de Robles on Tuesday, the 8th day of November, 1960, at which election shall be submitted to the qualified electors of the City the question of incurring a bonded indebtedness of said City for the objects and purposes set forth in the following proposition, to wit:

PROPOSITION: Shall the City of El Paso de Robles incur a bonded indebtedness in the amount of **\$75,000** for the acquisition, construction and completion, including any or all expenses incidental thereto, or connected therewith, of a municipal swimming pool together with bath houses, structures and facilities appurtenant thereto and the acquisition of all lands and easements necessary or useful therefor and by doing such incidental work as may be necessary to complete said improvements?

2. The estimated cost of the municipal improvement set forth in said proposition and the amount of indebtedness to be incurred therefor, including legal and other fees, costs of printing the bonds and other costs and expenses incidental or connected with the authorization, issuance and sale of the bonds, is the sum of \$75,000.

3. Said Council does hereby submit to the qualified electors of said City of El Paso de Robles at said special municipal election this ordinance and the said proposition set forth in Section 1 of this ordinance. The said Council proposes to issue and sell bonds of said City in the amount and for the objects and purposes specified in said proposition if two-thirds of the qualified electors voting on such proposition at said special municipal election shall vote in favor thereof.

4. If two-thirds of the qualified electors voting on such proposition vote in favor thereof, said proposition shall be deemed adopted. Said bonds shall be negotiable in form and of the character known as serial, and shall bear interest at a rate not exceeding six per cent (6%) per annum payable semi-annually except the first year which may be made payable at the end of said year.

5. Said special municipal election shall be held and conducted and the votes thereof canvassed, and the returns thereof made, and the results thereof ascertained and determined as herein provided; and in all particulars not prescribed by this ordinance said election shall be held as provided by law for the holding of municipal elections in said City.

6. The said special municipal election is hereby consolidated, as to all precincts which are the same for both elections, with the statewide general election which will be held within the County of San Luis Obispo and the State of California, on Tuesday, the 8th day of November, 1960. The special election shall be

held in the manner provided for the statewide general election and within the territory affected by the consolidation, the election precincts, polling places and voting booths shall, in every case, be the same and there shall be only one set of election officers in each of the precincts.

7. All persons qualified to vote at municipal elections in said City upon the date of the election herein provided for shall be qualified to vote upon the proposition submitted at said special municipal election.

8. The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Luis Obispo is hereby authorized to canvass the returns of said special election. The said election shall be held in all respects as if there were only one election, only one form of ballot shall be used, and the returns of said special municipal election need not be canvassed by this Council.

9. Ballots for said election shall be provided of the form and to the number provided by law. On said ballots two voting squares shall be set off to the right of said proposition submitted at said election, in the manner provided by law, one having the word "YES" printed before it and the other having the word "NO" printed before it.

10. Each voter may vote on the proposition hereby submitted. Each voter to vote for said proposition and for incurring the bonded indebtedness therefor shall cause a mark to be made in the blank space opposite the word "YES" on the ballot to the right of said proposition, and to vote against said proposition and against incurring the indebtedness therefor shall cause a mark to be made in the blank space opposite the word "NO" on the ballot to the right of said proposition.


11. The polls shall be opened at 7:00 o'clock A.M. of said day and shall be kept open until 7:00 o'clock P.M. of said day when the polls shall be closed, except as to voters in line as provided in Section 5734 of the Elections Code.


12. The County Clerk shall be responsible for the procuring of the necessary rosters, ballot boxes and all other supplies necessary to properly and lawfully conduct the election.

13. This ordinance shall be published once a week for two successive weeks in the Paso Robles Press, a newspaper of general circulation, printed and published less than six (6) days a week in said City, and such publication shall constitute notice of said election. No other notice of the election hereby called need be given.

14. This ordinance, being an ordinance calling and ordering an election, shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.


