

ORDINANCE NO. 311, N.S.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE MUNICIPAL CODE
OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLE

The City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles does ordain as follows:

SECTION I. That Title 5, Business License and Regulations; Chapter 5.04, Business License Tax; Section 5.04.300 of the Municipal Code of the City of El Paso de Robles be amended to read as follows:

Section 5.04. License Tax - Apartments. For the business of operating and renting apartments or multiple dwelling groups consisting of three or more rental units, the license tax shall be five dollars per year for each such rental unit. Apartment or multiple dwelling group as used in this section shall mean a building or portion thereof, or a group of buildings, located upon a lot or parcel of land under one ownership and being used and designated as independent family living units equipped with cooking facilities in each such unit but not including motels, automobile courts or boarding houses. The dwelling unit within these groupings and being occupied by the owner or operator of the group shall not be counted as a rental unit in the licensed number of units.

SECTION II. That Title 12, Vehicles and Traffic; of the Municipal Code of the City of El Paso de Robles be amended to read as follows:


Chapter 12.04. Definitions - 12.04.150, Vehicle. A device by which any persons or property may be propelled, moved or drawn upon a public street, alley or highway excepting a device moved by human power or used exclusively upon stationery rails or tracks.

Chapter 12.32. Standing, Stopping and Parking - 12.32.060.
A. TIME LIMIT. No person who owns or has possession, custody or control of any vehicle, trailer or trailer coach shall park such vehicle, trailer or trailer coach upon any street or alley for more than a consecutive period of forty-eight hours. B. REMOVAL. In the event a vehicle is parked or left standing upon a street or alley in excess of a consecutive period of one hundred and twenty hours, any member of the police department authorized by the chief of police may remove said vehicle from the street in the manner and subject to the requirements of Division 11, Chapter 10, Articles 1, 2 and 3 of the vehicle code of the State of California.


Chapter 12.38. Parking Restrictions - 12.38.020. All Night Parking Prohibited. When signs are erected giving notice thereof no person shall stop, stand or park a vehicle, trailer or trailer coach on any street or alley for a period of time longer than thirty minutes between the hours of two o'clock a.m. and six o'clock a.m. of any day.

Chapter 12.38. Parking Restrictions - 12.38.040. Parking Commercial Vehicles. No person shall park any commercial vehicle, trailer or trailer coach other than a passenger type automobile used predominantly for the purpose of transporting less than ten passengers or a pickup type truck with a unit mounted thereon that does not exceed a height greater than the drivers cab of such vehicle, longer than five hours upon any street or alley within the city (a) unless while loading or unloading property; and time, in addition to such five hour period, as is necessary to complete such work; or (b) when such vehicle, trailer or trailer coach is parked in connection with and the aid of the performance of service to or on a property in the block in which such vehicle, trailer or trailer coach is parked, and the time beyond such five hour period as is reasonably necessary to complete such service.
