

ORDINANCE NO. 241 N.S.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE SEWER SERVICE CHARGE
ORDINANCE TO REQUIRE PAYMENT OF SEWER CONNECTION FEES

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. That Title 14, Chapter 14.16 of the Municipal Code of the City of El Paso de Robles be amended by adding Sections thereto and reading as follows:

Section 14.16.080 - Sewer Connection Charges. Before any residential, business, commercial building or structure lying within the area being served by the city sewer system shall be connected to a sanitary sewer main operated and maintained by the City of El Paso de Robles, either direct or through any other sewer main, there shall be charged and collected by the city from the person requesting or making such connection, a fee for each structure or dwelling served in the amount of One Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$150.00) for each such unit.

Only one connection fee shall be collected from each structure, dwelling or building even though such structure, dwelling or building may be connected by more than one service lateral to the city sewer main.

Section 14.16.090 - Application of Revenue. All funds and moneys received from the collection of sewer connection charges as provided in Section 14.16.080 shall be deposited in a sinking fund account under the "Sewer Maintenance Fund" and shall be used only for the acquisition, construction and reconstruction of sewer trunk lines and mains, provided, however, that the city council may authorize, by resolution, that any such funds be applied to other uses toward the construction, maintenance and operation of the sanitary sewer system.

Section 14.16.100 - Penalties for Violation. Any person who shall violate any provisions of this Chapter shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine not exceeding Two Hundred Dollars or by imprisonment not exceeding thirty days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

SECTION II. That this ordinance shall become effective on January 1, 1971.
