

ORDINANCE NO. 579 N.S. N.S.

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE PENAL CODE REQUIREMENTS RELATING  
TO THE SELECTION AND TRAINING STANDARDS OF PUBLIC SAFETY  
DISPATCHERS

The City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles does  
ordain as follows:

SECTION I. The City of El Paso de Robles declares that  
it desires to qualify to receive aid from the State of  
California under the provisions of Section 13522, Chapter 1,  
of Title 4, Part 4, of the California Penal Code.

Section II. Pursuant to Section 13510(c), Chapter 1,  
the El Paso de Robles Police Department will adhere to  
standards for recruitment and training established by the  
California Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training  
(POST).

Section III. Pursuant to Section 13512, Chapter 1, the  
Commission and its representatives may make such inquiries as  
appropriate by the Commission to ascertain that the El Paso  
de Robles Police Department public safety dispatcher  
personnel adhere to standards for selection and training  
established by the Commission on Peace Officer Standards and  
Training.
