RESOLUTION NO. 100.

Adopted at a special meeting of the Board of Trustees  
on September 19, 1928.

BE IT, AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED:

That a great public calamity exists in this City of El Paso de Robles, to wit: a shortage of water, and this Board does now declare and determine that public interest and necessity demand the immediate expenditure of money to safeguard life, health and property within said City by the purchase of the necessary machinery to remedy such shortage, and that this Board do proceed to purchase, without advertising therefor, the following machinery to be used for the purpose of correcting said shortage and supplying said City with an ample supply of water without further delay: Two direct connected deep well turbine pumps with  $7\frac{1}{2}$  H.P. Motors.
