RESOLUTION NO. 105.

Adapted November 5, 1928.

WHEREAS, by resolution heretofore adopted, the City Attorney was directed to foreclose delinquent street assessments for the years 1924-5-6- and 7 on all property assessed to either of Cecelia Blackburn, E. M. Bennett, Edwin I. Bennett, Kate F. Bennett, Estella Bilton Dohring and Percy D. Bilton, et al., property on which such assessment was delinquent; and

WHEREAS, the City Attorney reports that he can collect in money a part of the delinquent assessments and taxes on said property and can arrange in other cases where such collections cannot be made in money that the owner will convey to the City in satisfaction of such delinquent taxes and assessments, the property on which the same is a lien, if the City will agree to grant the delinquent tax payer the right for thirteen months from date of such deed, to redeem such property by paying
