

RESOLUTION #284

RESOLUTION CLOSING A PORTION OF SIXTH STREET

The City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles, California, having on Monday, the 16th day of August, 1937, passed a resolution declaring its intention to order the following street work done, to wit:

The Closing of that portion of Sixth Street described as beginning at the Northeast corner of Block 98 of said City and running Westerly along the Northerly line of said Block 98 to the right of way of the Southern Pacific Company; thence Northerly along the Easterly line of said right of way eighty feet, more or less, to the Southerly line of Block 97; thence in an Easterly direction along the Southerly line of said Block 97, to the Southeast corner of said Block 97, thence at right angles Southerly a distance of eighty feet to the point of beginning.

And it appearing that the Superintendent of Streets did immediately thereafter cause to be conspicuously posted along the line of said above described work, in the manner and for the time required by law, notices of the passage of said resolution, and did also cause a similar notice in substance to be published four successive weeks in the Paso Robles Press, and it further appearing that said notices so posted and published, and the posting and publication thereof, were in all respects as required by the provisions of an act of the Legislature of the State of California, entitled; "An act to provide for laying out, opening, extending, widening, straightening, or closing up in whole or in part any street, square, land, alley, court, or place within municipalities, and to condemn and acquire any and all land and propertyn necessary or convenient for that purpose, " approved March 6, 1889, and the acts amendatory thereto.

And no objection having been made or filed to the doing of said work:

It is therefor ordered that the following described section of Sixth Street be and the same is hereby closed, to wit:

That portion of Sixth Street described as beginning at the Northeast corner of Block 98 of said City and running Westerly along the Northerly line of said Block 98 to the right of way of the Southern Pacific Company; thence Northerly along the Easterly line of said right of way eighty feet, more or less, to the Southerly line of Block 97; thence in an Easterly direction along the Southerly line of said Block 97, to the Southeast corner of said Block 97, thence at right angles Southerly a distance of eighty feet to the point of beginning.
