RESOLUTION NO. 587

RESOLUTION REQUESTING RELEASE OF WATER FROM SALINAS DAM.

BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED:

THAT WHEREAS, Engineering Studies indicate a dangerous overdraft on the available supply of underground water at
Paso Robles, and

WHEREAS, the 3000 acre feet of water released from the Upper Salinas Reservoir on order of the State Engineer flowed only to Templeton, five miles from our pumps, and

WHEREAS, additional water will be released by the U.S. Corps of Engineers only on the following condition; that should this release of water make pumping necessary at the Salinas Dam to supply existing legal water rights, the City of El Paso de Robles will guarantee pumping costs at not to exceed \$2.00 per acre foot on the amount of the release.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City of El Paso de Robles subject to the above conditions requests the immediate release from the Salinas Reservoir of 500 acre feet of water at the rate of one hundred twenty cubic feet per second and of such further releases as may be needed for the City. Except that this action shall be without prejudice, that the pumping cost obligation shall not extend after December 31, 1950, and it shall not be considered a precedent.
