RESOLUTION NO. 651

CLOSING AN ALLEY IN BLOCK 60

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles, having on the 21st day of February, 1949, passed a resolution of intention to order the following street work done, to-wit:

Close that alley running Easterly and Westerly through Block 60 in the City of El Paso de Robles a distance of 140 feet from the West line of Salinas Street to the East line of the alley running Northerly and Southerly through said Block 60, and

WHEREAS, it appears that the Superintendent of Streets did immediately thereafter cause to be conspicuously posted along the line of said above described work, in the manner and for the time required by law, notices of the passage of said resolution, and did also cause a notice similar in substance to be published four successive weeks in the Press-Advertiser, and it appearing that said notices so posted and published were in all respects as required by the provisions of an act of the legislature of the State of California, entitled: "An act to provide for the laying out, opening, extending, widening, straightening, or closing up in whole or part any street, square, land, alley, court, or place within municipalities, and to condemn and acquire any and all land and property necessary or convenient for that purpose", approved March 6, 1889, and the acts amendatory thereto, and

WHEREAS, there has been no objection made or filed to the doing of said work.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the above described alley in Block 60 be and the same is hereby closed.
