

RESOLUTION NO. 652

AN INTENTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL TO REZONE
AN AREA BETWEEN 30th and 36th STREETS AND
SPRING AND OAK STREETS IN THE CITY OF EL
PASO DE ROBLES.

The City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles does hereby resolve as follows:

That it is the intention of the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles, to do the following rezoning within said City to-wit:

To amend Ordinance No. 105 N.S., and the Zoning Plan pertaining thereto, so as to change the area in the City bounded as follows from an C-2 Zoning District to an R-1 Zoning District:

Beginning at a point on the North line of Thirtieth Street 150 feet Westerly from the West line of Spring Street and running thence Westerly along the North line of Thirtieth Street, 150 feet to the East line of Oak Street; thence Northerly along the East line of Oak Street to Thirty-fourth Street and continuing Northerly along the East line of Lots 7 and 8 in Block 210 to the South line of Thirty-sixth Street; thence Easterly along the South line of Thirty-sixth Street 150 feet; thence at right angles Southerly parallel to and 150 feet Westerly of the West line of Spring Street to the North line of Thirtieth Street and point of beginning.


That a Public Hearing be held by the Planning Commission of the City of El Paso de Robles, California, on the 13th day of June, 1949, for the purpose of hearing any objections to the above described rezoning.

That the City Clerk of the City of El Paso de Robles give notice of the passage of this Resolution of Intention by advertising in the Press-Advertiser, a newspaper of general circulation, published in the City of El Paso de Robles.

That the Planning Commission give additional notice of the time and place of such hearing by posting public notices not less than 10 days prior to the date set for said hearing, such notices being placed not more than 500 feet distant apart along

each and every street upon which the property proposed to be rezoned abuts and such posting shall extend along said street or streets a distance of not less than 300 feet from the exterior limits of such properties as are proposed for rezoning.
